"Ramsey County will center residents to meet the needs of community and ensure that county services, applications, and programs are inclusive, accessible, efficient and provided with exemplary service."


A key part of the Residents First priority is to improve the resident experience when accessing County services at facilities. The Resident First Facilities work developed over many years, recommended a central "hub" location and neighborhood locations:

Residents First Facilities

Saint Paul location, downtown, for core and other beneficial services, access to transit and affordable parking.


Neighborhood locations with a mix of tailored services, scalable and flexible (urban/suburban existing or new, i.e. SPOC).

Mobile Service Teams with integrated service offerings at partner & community sites.

In August 2020, Ramsey County stood up its first Service Centers to offer assistance with a wide range of county programs and services. There are currently three Service Centers and seven partner locations.
