Project Scope

- Add a complete security fence around the campus
- Install additional security cameras


Business Case

- The campus is a major public facing service center for residents and a critical public safety infrastructure for the city and the county
- There is no comprehensive permanent security fence (only partial)
- The campus has been and remains a target and event site
- In general, Ramsey County and Saint Paul are high profile locations
- Temporary measures (overtime and short-term fencing) are costly and look like a military fort while limiting movement



Saint Paul Campus Security

- Quotes completed with Property Management
- Design and appearance is friendly; not military or fortress like
- Continuity of government is ensured with security fencing
- Without a permanent solution:
 - Six deputies are required to secure the campus.
 - Deputies assigned to campus security on overtime (over \$12,000 per day) and unavailable to provide other emergency services
 - Rental fencing and barriers are costly
- Funding is requested over three years, with year one focused on design build with stakeholders and then implementation
- Phased approach: \$100k in 2024 and \$495k in 2025 and 2026



Saint Paul Campus Security

- This request is partly in response to civil unrest that took place across the United States and in the Twin Cities in recent year
- It is estimated that throughout Minnesota over \$500 million in property damage occurred, with the majority in Minneapolis and Saint Paul.
- There were several demonstrations and creditable threats made against the campus
- Government buildings have become a target and site for demonstrations
- The campus is located about one mile east of the State Capitol and several state buildings
