

Training Center and Range Updates

- Provide safety and training enhancements to the Firearms Range to comply with Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requirements and best practices
- Replacement of the heating and ventilation system, sound abatement system, and targeting system
- This request will also fund researching transitioning the range to lead-free for health and environmental reasons
- The training provided on the range is required by the State of Minnesota
- Firearms Range was built in 2003 with 10 lanes (20 years ago)



Training Center and Range Updates

- Current systems are approaching 20 years old and are in need of replacement
- Ventilation system, which is now very loud, is at risk of total failure
- Sound abatement system aged and does not reduce noise
- Target system was designed to be used in lanes, which no longer conforms to current training standards
- Funding will provide for employee safety during training and ensure requirements for air, sound, and safety are met
- The county could be found in violation of OSHA safety standards.
- Funding is requested in 2027 (\$265k) and 2028 (\$310k)
