1DHOkay the recorder is going. Uh my name is Doug Henning. I'm a Special Agent2with the Minnesota of Be, the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension. This,3this is my partner Special Agent Chris Olson. Um the date today is 7-7 of 2016.4The time right now is approximately 1:42. This'll be in reference to BCA case5number 2016-433. Um and we will be speaking with Jeronimo, J-E-R-O-N-I-M-O,6is that spelled correctly and you don't have a middle name?

- 7 JY No middle name.
- 8 DH Okay. Your last name is Yanez?
- 9 JY Yanez

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- 10 DH Yanez?
- 11 JY Yeah.
- 12 DH And that's Y-A-N-E-Z?
- 13 JY Correct.
- 14 DH And your date of birth is 3-8 of 1988?
- 15 JY Correct.
- 16 DH Okay. What is your address at work?
- 17 JY 3301 Silver Lake Road Northeast, St Anthony, Minnesota 55418.
- 18 DH Okay and your work phone number would be 612-782-3350?
- 19 JY Correct.
- 20 DH Okay. Um, and you work for the City of St Anthony?
- 21 JY Correct.
- 22 DH In what capacity?
- 23 JY As a patrol officer.
- 24 DH Okay. Um, how long have you worked for St Anthony?
- 25 JY I've worked for St Anthony for about four and a half years.
- 26 DH Okay. Prior to working for St Anthony did you work anywhere else?



27 28 29 30	JΥ	Yes. Before I worked with St Anthony Police Department I worked for a contract company who was, who worked with Immigration Custom Enforcement and I worked as a, supervision case specialist which was just a um I watched over people who were here in the U.S. illegally.
31	DH	Okay.
32 33 34	JΥ	And then before that I worked for Whalen Security as a security guard, worked at Seagate Technology. And then, before that I was a student at Minnesota State University, Mankato.
35 36	DH	Okay. So your only, law enforcement experience is with St Anthony Police Department?
37	JY	Correct.
38	DH	Okay. Um and you're assigned as a patrol officer?
39	JY	Yes.
40	DH	What shift are you assigned to?
41	JY	I work the night shift. 6:00 am to 6:00 pm or 6:00 pm to 6:00 am.
42	DH	Twelve hour shift?
43	JY	Yes.
44	DH	And how long have you been working nights?
45 46 47	JΥ	I've been working nights for the past, four and a half years. There's been a couple, rotations where I've worked days but that was, during FTO and just this last rotation for about three months.
48 49	DH	Okay so, so during your initial hire you were in a training period and you worked, you worked different shifts
50	JY	Correct.
51	DH	to work with different training officers?
52	JY	Yes.
53	DH	Okay. Uh can you tell me about your training that you've had?
54	JY	I have (inaudible)
55	DH	Police related training.
56 57	JY	Okay. Uh police related training I'm certified by POST board to be a police officer here in the State of Minnesota.
58	DH	Okay.
59 60 61	JΥ	I have skills training through Hibbing Community College. Um I've also done um some training through the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension um to keep my POST credits updated.
62	DH	Okay.
63 64	JY	And current. And, I did my four year degree at Minnesota State University uh Mankato. And got a four year bachelor of science in law enforcement.
65	DH	Okay. What's your POST number? Do you know it?

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66	JY	My POST number is 21256.
67 68	DH	Okay. And I forgot to say this right away when we started but you're, you're represented here by uh two attorneys?
69	JY	Correct.
70	DH	Um, Tom Kelly and Robert Fowler?
71	JY	Correct.
72	DH	Okay. Um why don't we keep going. So you do use of force?
73	JY	Yes.
74	DH	On a regular basis, how often do you do use of force with St Anthony?
75	JY	Once a year.
76	DH	Once a year?
77 78 79	JΥ	We do a, a use of force once a year. Taser training once a year. Firearms training, multiple times a year. We shoot through uh Ramsey County Law Enforcement Center so we do there, I think quarterly training it is.
80	DH	Okay.
81	JY	And then we also have our own department training shoot.
82	DH	Okay.
83	JY	That we do yearly.
84	DH	Okay so you go to several ranges a year?
85	JY	Correct.
86	DH	When's the last time you were at the range?
87	JY	Um, May?
88	DH	May?
89	JY	Yes.
90	DH	Okay.
91	JY _,	And that was for training.
92 93	DH	Okay. Have you had any specialized training? SWAT? Anything else? Anything like that?
94	JY	No specialized training like SWAT.
95	DH	No specialized training?
96	JY	No.
97	DH	Okay. Um you said you're a patrol officer?
98	JY	Correct.
99	DH	So in that capacity you wear a uniform?
100	JY	Yes.
101	DH	Can you explain that to me?

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102	JY	So
103	DH	Or describe it to me.
104 105	JY	It's a, fully marked uniform with vest, badge on my uh left sh', left breast. Um a nametag. A states that I'm a police officer, my name on my right breast.
106	DH	Okay.
107 108 109 110	JΥ	I have a, pretty visible uh exterior vest carrier or bullet proof vest and I have a full utility belt. That's very observable. And it's obvious that I'm a police officer. I have patches on both arms that say I'm a representative of St Anthony Police Department and a police officer, St Anthony Police Department.
111	DH	Okay so what color is your uniform?
112	JY	It's navy blue.
113	DH	Navy blue?
114	JY	Yes.
115	DH	And then you said you wear a gun belt as well?
116	JY	Correct.
117	DH	Can you tell me about the equipment that you carry on your gun belt?
118 119	JY	Yes I have, for my depart my de, department uh firearm I have a Sig Sauer P20 45 caliber
120	DH	Okay
121 122 123	JΥ	That I carry on my right hand side. Uh I also have two sets of handcuffs. I have a Taser. I have mace. I have a baton. I have my portable radio. And I have a set of keys um that's all I can remember that I have on my
124	DH	Okay you wear
125	JY	utility belt for now. And I wear that every day that I work.
126	DH	Okay.
127 128	JY	Um and in the same position all the time. Everything is in the same position. Uh so I can keep track of where everything is.
129	DH	Okay does your department have body cameras or anything of that nature?
130 131	JY	Our department does not have body cameras but our fully marked uh squad vehicles have squad cameras. Um dash mounted cams.
132	DH	Okay.
133	JY	And they have a microphone as well for and it does audio and visual recording.
134	DH	Okay. So that's, uh when you say it's got a microphone is that a remote mic?
135	JY	Yes.
136	DH	Is that something that you wear on your person?
137	JY	Yes.
138	DH	Okay. Is that policy that you wear that?

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139	JY	Uh I can't recall if it's policy.
140	DH	Okay.
141	JY	But I know there's something in our policy that states that we should wear it.
142	DH	Okay.
143	JY	Um, and yeah I wear it all the time.
144	DH	So do you know if you were wearing it yesterday?
145	JY	I was wearing my microphone last night.
146	DH	Okay do you know if it was working?
147	JY	I can't recall, if it was working or not.
148	DH	Okay.
149 150 151	JY	Um, I had my attention focused on uh suspect vehicle that I was pulling over. As I was pulling it out of the holster, I can't remember if I was pull, pulling it out of the holster or if I already had it in my vest but I know I had it, on my person.
152	DH	So when you say holster it sits in a holster in the car?
153	JY	In a charger.
154	DH	In a charger?
155	JY	Yes.
156	DH	And stays in the car?
157	JY	Yes.
158	DH	So whoever drives, so your car is, is driven by more than just you?
159	JY	Correct.
160 161	DH	So, when your shift you, you'd pick it up and you put it on your person. Does it just clip on your uniform?
162 163	JY	It's a little, two inch by two inch square that just, you can just put it anywhere. I put it inside my pocket with no obstructions over it so it can get clear audio.
164	DH	Okay.
165	JY	Um, for (inaudible)
166	DH	And that's the piece of equipment that you showed me last night?
167	JY	Correct.
168 169	DH	Okay. Um, so at the beginning of your shift do you test this equipment to make sure it's working or not or?
170	JY	Uh I do not test it. But I did make traffic stops beforehand.
171	DH	Okay.
172 173	JY	I made two traffic stops beforehand I believe and uh the audio was working (inaudible)
174	DH	Okay so you reviewed those traffic stops after the fact?

175	JY	I can't remember if I reviewed 'em or not.
176	DH	Okay.
177	JY	But I, I know I had the uh microphone on my person.
178	DH	And it was
179	JY	In the same spot that I put it and it was recording and
180	DH	Okay.
181	JY	it was saying that the mic was active on the um the video screen.
182 183	DH	Okay so you can see some type of monitor or display that tells you this is working, this is operational and the two pieces equipment are
184	JY	Correct.
185	DH	are hooked up and
186	JY	Correct.
187	DH	Okay. Um so with that can you tell me about the car you drive?
188 189 190 191 192	ĴΥ	Yes it's a 2015 Dodge Charger. Uh fully marked with St Anthony uh placards on each side. The squad that I was driving was marked as uh 700 and 4. It has a light bear, light bar on top. Uh push bumper in front. It's black and white. The door's on the passenger side and I think it's on the passenger side and driver's side I think they're both white.
193	DH	Okay.
194	JY	And then the rest of the vehicle is black.
195	DH	Okay.
196 197	JY	And then my squad vehicle is equipped with very bright LED lights. Red, blue and white flashing lights.
198	DH	Okay so
199	JY	That are visible
200	DH	On the top?
201	JY	…from I would say more than a mile away.
202 203	DH	Okay. Are those, are is, is there more than just that light bar on top? You said there was an external light bar? Are there lights
204	JY	Correct
205	DH	in the back
206 207 208	ΥL	So there's a light bar on top and then the headlights flash on and off. And then when I turn all the way on there's a, opticom that blinks repeatedly and very fast and it's hard to miss. And then my tail lights also go on and off.
209	DH	Okay.
210	JY	And then there's a light bar I think on the back of the squad as well.
211 212	DH	So when you activate all your lights it's very readily apparent that this is a police vehicle?

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213	JY	Correct.
214	DH	Okay. Um I want to go back to your uniform for just a second.
215	JY	Yes.
216 217	DH	You've been wearing this uniform, the same uniform for the past four and a half years?
218	JY	Yes.
219 220	DH	Has, has uh anybody ever mistaken you for anything other than a police officer when you're wearing this uniform?
221	JY	Nobody has mistaken me for anything else, other than…
222	DH	Okay.
223	JY	I'm a police officer.
224 225 226	DH	You've approached people, you've had numerous contacts and it's always apparent to people that you're a law enforcement officer of some, of some type with, with St Anthony?
227	JY	Correct.
228	DH	Okay. Um, we'll continue with the car.
229	JY	Okay.
230	DH	Is there any special equipment that you carry in the car?
231 232	JY	Uh there is a squad computer which also has a, mobile air card. I think it's through Verizon wireless.
233	DH	Okay.
234 235 236 237 238	ΥL	Which gives us internet access and we have um two computerized dispatch systems. In, one for Ramsey County and then one for Hennepin County. I use the one for Hennepin County the majority of the time. And uh we have all of our access to our primary weapon which is a M4 that's mounted on the roof of the vehicle.
239	DH	Okay.
240 241 242	JΥ	And then we have squad sirens, in the same place where I activate my lights. And then we have two squad radios. Um one for car to car and to listen to the opposite county that we're not in.
243	DH	Okay.
244	JY	And then one for the county that we're in.
245	DH	Okay. Cuz, St Anthony services more than one, more than St Anthony?
246 247	JΥ	Correct. St Anthony we, we work with Falcon Heights and Lauderdale. Which we're contracted with.
248	DH	Okay.
249	JY	And so we have one squad in Falcon Heights and Lauderdale.
250	DH	Okay.

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251	JY	It's 24/7 coverage.
252	DH	And, is that where you were working last night?
253	JY	I was working in the City of Lauderdale last night.
254 255 256	DH	Okay. Um, do you check all this equipment prior to starting your shift to make sure it was operational? Your lights, your sirens stuff like that before you rolled out of the
257	JY	I didn't test my sirens.
258	DH	Okay
259	JY	Um I know that my emergency lights were working.
260	DH	Okay.
261 262	JY	And active because I was able to pull over uh two other vehicles prior to the suspect vehicle that we're here talking about or interviewing about.
263	DH	Okay.
264 265 266	JY	Um and I remember going back to my squad and seeing that the lights are working. And I remember from this incident as well that the lights were on and they were active as well.
267 268	DH	Okay. Uh just before we get too far before we start talking about what happened yesterday can you tell me about your education?
269 270 271 272	JΥ	I, went to high school in South St Paul. Graduated and went to Minnesota State University, Mankato. Where I got my four year degree uh in law enforcement. Bachelor of science and then incorporated with that uh is our skills portion which is through Hibbing Community College.
273	DH	But that was conducted down in Mankato though correct?
274	JY	Yes.
275	DH	Okay. So Hibbing hosts the training but they take it down to Mankato?
276	JY	Yes.
277	DH	Just to make it easy on the students?
278	JY	Yes.
279	DH	Okay. Um, why don't we go ahead and, tell me uh yesterday you got to work.
280	JY	Yes.
281	DH	So tell me about your day yesterday.
282 283 284 285 286 287 288 289 289 290	ТК	Before you get started on that if I may uh I wanted to make clear that um that the officer is going to be speaking here from the best of his recollection, um as, as you know this is only um less than fifteen hours uh since the time of this incident uh there's always stress related to that. In addition to that this would be the normal time that this officer would be um sleeping. And he's only had a couple hours of sleep. And I say that only because I, I know he's gonna make his best efforts here to give you an accurate uh recollection of the events but in the event that we do come up with something that we've forgotten or that has been misstated um we, we would like the opportunity to supplement or modify the

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291 292 293 294		statement that he's giving now with something that occurs to him later or that he realizes that he has misstated now. So we'll do our best to make sure that, then. This is his, his uh most accurate recollection right now. But we want the opportunity to um supplement the record so to speak at a later time.
295	DH	Absolut
296	JY	That is, that is true
297	CO	And for the benefit of the transcriptionist that was Counselor Tom Kelly.
298	DH	Okay.
299	со	Alright.
300 301 302	DH	And absolutely if you, if you come up with something that you would like to clarify at a later time, anything we can, we can certainly sit down again and go over that.
303 304 305	ТК	So when he speaks he'll be speaking as to the best of his recollection right now and, and um and uh it's probably um unlikely that we'll have anything to um add later on but in the event that we do we'll, we'll notify both of you.
306 307	DH	And Chris and I, Chris and I will certainly make ourselves available for that. So with that said um what time did you get to work yesterday?
308	JY	I got to work at around 5:20…
309	DH	Okay.
310 311 312	JY	in the afternoon. And I went in to our locker room and I changed in my full uniform that I described to you earlier in the interview. And we had shift change and we uh, with the day shift and then
313	DH	What does that entail? Shift change.
314	JY	Shift change
315	DH	Is there a rollcall or anything like that?
316 317 318	JY	There's, rollcall if there is any rollcall um usually there's no rollcall unless it's, um something that's a critical incident or a burglary or a string of uh theft from autos in the area then we get notified about it um
319	DH	Okay
320	JY	We get notified about everything that's, um that we would expect to get called for.
321	DH	Okay.
322	JY	And what day shift finds important for us to know for night shift.
323	DH	Okay.
324 325 326 327 328 329	JY	Um after that it was only, we were at minimum so it was myself was working the City of Lauderdale. And then which is 6921 and then my partner, Joseph Kauser who was working in 69 as 6920 in the City of Falcon Heights. And then my other partner, Tressa Sunde who was 6910 in the City of St Anthony. And we were, my partner Officer Kauser and I were uh we give all of our radio traffic on the Ramsey County main so

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331 [.] 332	JY	we monitor on our car to car and our, and Hennepin County on our car to car radio.
333	DH	Okay.
334 335 336 337 338	JΥ	Um, I we went to the, we went to our contract cities. Um dropped off our lunch at Falcon Heights Fire Department. And then we started patrolling. I was working the City of Lauderdale. I was running speed radar and just looking for vehicles to pull over and uh just driving around the city and just making contacts with our citizens.
339	DH	Okay.
340	JY	And uh I pulled over two vehicles that I can remember. And then uh…
341	DH	Do you remember what you pulled 'em over for?
342 343 344 345 346 347 348 349 350 351 352 353 354 355 356	JΥ	I pulled two vehicles over for speeding. They both received citations. And then um it was kinda slow for a little bit I think. And then I can't remember exactly where I was but I was keeping my eye on 2424 Larpenteur which is a convenience store on Larpenteur at the intersection of Larpenteur and Eustice. It's on the southwest corner of the intersection. Um, I wanted to pay attention to that because we had a strong armed robbery last week uh which involved two African American males um, one having a firearm and pointing it at the clerk and then the other uh the victim told me that he also had a firearm but I wasn't able to see it when the video was reviewed. Um, so I was sitting at a intersection and I see a white vehicle. I can't remember what kind of vehicle it was. Um but I see two occupants. What I believed was two occupants inside the car. And I couldn't make out the passenger. But I knew the passenger had a hat on. And I couldn't make out if it was a guy or girl I just knew that they were both African American and the driver uh appeared to me that he appeared to match the uh physical description of the one of our suspects from the strong arm robbery, gunpoint.
357	DH	Okay.
358	JY	Uh (inaudible)
359	DH	What is that description?
360 361	JY	Um it was a (sigh) I can't remember the height, weight but I remember that it was, the male had dreadlocks around shoulder length.
362	DH	Um-hm.
363 364 365 366	ΥL	Or longer hair around shoulder length. And, um it wasn't specified if it was corn rows or dreadlocks or straight hair. Um and then just kind of distinct facial features with like a kind of like a wide set nose and uh I saw that in the driver of the vehicle.
367	DH	Okay.
368 369 370 371 372 373	JΥ	That uh this incidents about uh at the intersection of about Larpenteur and Carl, Larpenteur and Eustice, that area. Uh so I get behind the vehicle to see if I can see any uh violations, to get a good ID on the, driver. I run the plate. And I can't remember who it comes back to. And uh I call out to my partner on my car to car radio because that's where we do all of our radio tr or our uh radio traffic is on car to car unless it's something like a in progress call then we go on our main to main our main radio. So I got on my car to car radio. I let Officer Kauser know

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that I was behind a, a suspect vehicle traveling eastbound Larpenteur and I told 375 Officer Kauser that it was occupied two times and I couldn't make out who the 376 passenger was. And, I told him that the driver appeared to, match the physical 377 description of our suspect from the strong arm robbery and I told him that I 378 wanted to wait for Officer, I told Officer Kauser that I wanted to wait for him um 379 for backup. Uh just in case cuz I didn't know who I was pulling over. 380 Right. 381 DH I just knew that the driver matched the physical description. And we were JΥ 382 approaching the intersection of Larpenteur and Snelling and it's a very busy 383 intersection. Uh I can't remember what time it was specifically but I, believe it 384 was around 8:45-ish to 9:00 o'clock-ish. Um and it's still pretty busy in that area. 385 Heavy traffic. Uh would be a close heavy foot traffic with uh walkers, joggers. Um 386 people living in the apartments in that area. Uh restaurants. And I decided to 387 initiate the traffic stop just west of the intersection, on Larpenteur west of Fry 388 Street. 389 Okay. 390 DH Because, just in case anything happened I wanted to make sure that, nobody's JY 391 lives were in jeopardy and we were out of heavy traffic and innocent bystanders 392 and uh all that. And uh so I initiated the traffic stop. At that point Officer Kauser 393 got behind me. Um I was keeping my eyes on the vehicle and 394 Just let me stop you for just a second. DH 395 JY Yeah. 396 So the reason that you did all this stuff, uh you, you waited for a partner? DH 397 Yes I waited for a partner because ... JΥ 398 Um, you waited for a safe area to make the stop? DH 399 JY Correct. 400 And this is based on information because this guy fit the description of an 401 DH individual that had, had been armed and committed a robbery? 402 JY Correct. 403 The week prior or a couple days prior? DH 404 Uh the week prior. I... JY 405 DH Okay. 406 ...can't remember what day but it was last week. JΥ 407 Okay. But typically, under normal circumstances you conduct traffic stops on DH 408 409 your own? JY Correct. 410 Regular traffic stops? 411 DH Regular traffic stops on my own. JY 412 DH Okay. 413 And then I update my partners if I'm, if I'm okay code 4. JY 414

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415	DH	Yeah.
416	JY	Um or if I need their backup.
417	DH	And code 4 just for people that don't understand (inaudible)
418	JY	Code 4 is, meaning you're okay.
419	DH	(inaudible) okay
420	JY	Don't need assistance.
421	DH	I'm safe, the situation has been deemed, stable.
422	JY	Correct.
423	DH	Okay.
424	JY	And, I initiated the traf, what's that?
425	DH	So but you waited for a partner? You called a partner?
426 427 428	JY	Yes I waited for the partner. I waited to pass the partner and uh I was behind the vehicle and I saw my partner I was about, a quarter mile ahead of him. And he was still trying to catch up.
429	DH	Okay.
430 431	JY	To, get behind us. And I decided to, activate my emergency lights so we wouldn't be in that heavy foot traffic, vehicle area.
432	DH	Okay
433	JY	With innocent people at the intersection of Larpenteur and Snelling.
434	DH	Okay.
435 436	JY	I just wanted to be as safe as possible. And have everybody safe as possible. And uh…
437	DH	Okay.
438 439 440 441 442	ĴΥ	(sigh) I activated my emergency lights. I started getting out of my squad. Um, I can't remember I had my, eyes focused on the driver cuz that's what I always do. I get out of my squad vehicle and I approach the vehicle as I always do. Looking inside, looking for any furtive movements. Um looking to see who's inside the car. And as soon as I get up to the car I'm hit with a, odor of burning marijuana.
443	DH	Okay.
444 445 446	JΥ	And I know it's already been smoked and I've been around uh through my training I've been around burnt marijuana and uh as a police officer I've been around burnt marijuana and uh fresh marijuana.
447	DH	Okay.
448	JY	So I know the distinct smells between both.
449	DH	Okay.
450 451 452 453	ΥL	I smelled burnt marijuana. And then I see a female child in the back. And then I see a front seat passenger, adult female uh in the front seat. And then I see the suspect up driving, seatbelt on leaned back in his seat. He had his, left arm over the steering wheel and then he had both hands in view. And then

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454	DH	Initially?
455 456 457 458 459 460 461 462 463 464 465	DH	Initially. And then I told them the reason for the traffic stop and then I wasn't going to say anything about the marijuana yet because I didn't want to scare him or have him react in a defensive manner. Um, he didn't make direct eye contact with me and it was very hard to hear him. Uh he was almost mumbling when he was talking to me. And he was directing his voice away from me as he was speaking and as I was asking questions. Uh he kept his, hands in view and then I uh I believe I asked for, his license and insurance. And then I believe they told me, they asked for the reason for my traffic stop. And I told 'em the reason was the only, I think I told 'em the only rea, the reason I pulled you over is because the only active brake light working was the rear passenger side brake light. Okay.
466	JY	And then I received the insurance and then

468 469 470 471	JY	I can't remember if I asked for his ID or not but I, I know I asked for his ID or his driver's license. And then he goes I have a gun. And as I'm telling him or as he's telling me that he's reaching down between his right leg, his right thigh area and the center console.
472	DH	Okay.
473 474	JY .	And he's reaching down and I believe I'm telling him something along the lines of don't reach for it, don't do it. Referring to the, uh the firearm.
475	DH	Yep.
476 477 478 479 480	JY	Because usually people that carry firearms carry 'em on their waistband. Um and or in between the seats and being that the vehicle smelled the inside of the vehicle smelled like marijuana um I didn't know if he was keeping it on him for protection, for, from a, a drug dealer or anything like that or any other people trying to rip him. Rip him meaning steal from him.
481	DH	Rob him.
482 483	JY	Um rob him. Um and I couldn't see uh the area wi, where he was reaching his hand down towards.
484	DH	Okay.
485 486 487	JY	And I, believe I continued to tell him don't do it or don't reach for it and he still continued to move. And, it appeared to me that he had no regard to what I was saying. He didn't care what I was saying. He still reached down.
488	DH	He didn't stop moving his hand?
489 490	JY	He didn't stop reaching, for his hand he, he didn't stop moving his hand and it still went down.
491	DH	Okay.

And his hand made like a C shape type um type shape and it 500 appeared to me that he was wrapping something around his fingers and almost 501 like if I were to put my uh hand around my gun like putting my hand up to the butt 502 503 of the gun.

And then I lost view of it. Cuz he kept canting his shoulder and then I believe I JY 507 told him again I can't remember don't do it. And then he still kept moving his 508 hand and at this point I looked and saw something in his hand. It was dark inside 509 the vehicle. I was trying to fumble my way through under stress to look and see 510 what it was to make sure uh what I was seeing. But I wasn't given enough time 511 and like I said he had no regard for what I was saying. Didn't follow my direction. 512 And, uh he started reaching out and then pulling uh away from his uh his right 513 thigh. I don't know if it was in his pocket or in between the seats or the center 514 console. But I, I know he had an object and it was dark. And he was pulling it out 515 with his right hand. And as he was pulling it out I, a million things started going 516 through my head. And I thought I was gonna die. And, I was scared because, I 517 didn't know if he was gonna, I didn't know what he was gonna do. He just had 518 somethin' uh his hands and he, the first words that he said to me were, some of 519 the first words he said is that he had a gun. And I thought he was reaching for the 520 gun. I thought he had the gun in his hand, in his right hand. And I thought he had 521 it enough to where all he had to do is just pull it out, point it at me, move his 522 trigger finger down on the trigger and let off rounds. And I had no other option 523 than, to take out my firearm and, and I shot. Um I shot him. I don't remember the 524 first couple shots. I, believe I remember the last two shots. And I believe one of 525 the shots went into his left arm. Um, as I was shooting uh I, I kept watching him. 526 And I, I remember smelling the gun smoke and the bright flashes from the 527 muzzle. And then I heard, a couple pops uh from my firearm. Um and then my 528 partner was on the opposite side of the vehicle. Uh watch, looking in and I 529 directed my gunfire down as best as I could. Away from, not trying to put the little 530 girl's life at jeopardy or the passenger or my partner because they were, in the 531 line of my fire. 532

And, I let off the rounds and then after the rounds were off, the little girls was screaming. I held the suspect at gunpoint. His arms came up into view. And they were up by his chest. Cuz I wanted her to be safe and I told Officer Kauser or I told her one of the two to go run out of the car and run to Officer Kauser or Officer Kauser to get her. And then I turned my attention to the front seat passenger. I didn't, point my firearm at her. I still had it on the suspect. Cuz he was still moving. And he,

But I told her 591 to keep her hands in view. She complied with my direction. And she kept her 592 hands in view, around the dashboard area and then she, and the uh Roseville 593 officers arrived. Officer Kauser was the first one to say, go out on the Ramsey 594 County main saying that there were shots fired. I know there was a little bit of 595 confusion because dispatch was (coughs) dispatch uh called back uh for 596 whoever was calling to say, did you say shots fired or something like that. And 597 then uh that's when, a Roseville officer arrived and then uh I told them that I had 598 the suspect at gunpoint. And two officers arrived behind me. I don't remember 599 who they were but they were Roseville officers. And they stood behind me with 600 their guns drawn on the suspect and they took the female front seat passenger 601 out at gunpoint, detained her, put her in handcuffs, escorted her back to one of 602 the squads.
