


As the River Capital, Saint Paul's unique history, culture and economy are connected to the 17 miles of Mississippi River that flow through it.

Saint Paul's future is the river, which is why business, government and nonprofit leaders are collectively focused on reconnecting to its greatest natural asset. More than \$2.7 billion of investment is currently planned or underway for projects along Saint Paul's riverfront alone.

Reconstruction of an 80-yearold regionally significant bridge and tunnel along the river bluff that serves as a gateway for more than seven




million visitors each year. A separated bike and pedestrian trail are also included.

Lower Landing Park

Renovations to the 21.4 acre park along the Mississippi River will include entryway and plaza improvements, a dog park, and a nature trail. Viking River Cruises will also dock at Lower Landing Park.
