

## Student Intern – Environmental Health Division – Summer 2019

The Environmental Health Division of Saint – Paul Ramsey County Public Health has an opening for a Student Intern position. This is a paid position working principally in the Solid Waste Services program but work may include collaborative efforts with other Division environmental health program areas. The person in this position will work with other Environmental Health Specialists, supervisors and staff.

### Examples of projects and work assignments include:

- Inventory, label, and distribute trash and recycling receptacles to county-owned and leased spaces;
- Conduct survey work at county household hazardous waste and yard waste collection facilities;
- Assist with trash and recycling efforts at the Ramsey County Fair;
- Assist with sale and distribution of backyard compost bins;
- Promote organics recycling;
- Stock biodegradable bags at organics collection sites and other public distribution points;
- Coordinate pickup/drop off of event recycling containers by residents.

### Minimum Qualifications

**Education:** Enrollment at a post-secondary school with coursework in environmental health, the physical, or biological sciences, or a related environmental health or natural resources field.

**Experience:** None.

**Other:** A valid driver's license is required.
