

## **Dislocated Worker and WIOA Adult Training Service Requirements**

	ning services are conditional based on the following criteria. All criteria must be met to qualify for ning.
	<ul> <li>Through Career Services alone, the individual is unlikely or unable to:</li> <li>Obtain employment that leads to self-sufficiency, or</li> <li>Gain wages comparable to, or higher than, wages from previous employment</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The training service is needed to:</li> <li>Obtain employment that leads to self-sufficiency, or</li> <li>Gain wages comparable to, or higher than, wages from previous employment</li> </ul>
	The Individual <b>has the skills and qualifications to successfully participate</b> in the selected program of training services
	The selected training program is <b>directly linked to employment opportunities</b> in the area, or within an area the individual is willing to relocate
	The individual is determined eligible in accordance with the priority system in effect for adults (WIOA Adult participants only)
Additionally, a determination should be made whether participant:	
	Is <b>unable to obtain grant assistance from other sources</b> to pay the costs of such training, including state-funded training funds or Federal Pell Grants
	Is currently <b>waiting for Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) petition determination</b> . If the petition is denied, the participant can continue training under WIOA
