District Referendum Revenue  
Authorization**

The board of Independent School District No. 624 (White Bear Lake Area Schools) has proposed to renew its existing referendum revenue authorization of \$1,538.31 per pupil. This proposed referendum revenue authorization would replace the school district's existing revenue authorization which will expire after taxes payable in 2018.
