

Notice of Absentee Ballot Board Operations

For the Nov. 3, 2020 general election, the Ramsey County absentee ballot board meets daily during normal business hours, beginning 9/21/2020, through Nov. 10. The absentee ballot board will be open additional hours on Sat. 10/31 (10 a.m. to 3 p.m.) and Tues., Nov. 3 (8 a.m. to 8 p.m.).

Challengers have a right to challenge accepted absentee ballots at the meeting of the absentee ballot board. In order to act as a challenger, an individual must provide a written letter from a political party or nonpartisan candidate. Challengers must put the challenge in writing. Minnesota Statutes only authorize the challenge of accepted ballots; a decision to reject a ballot may not be challenged.

The counting center will be open to the public at Metro Square (121 7th Pl E, St Paul, MN 55101) from Mon. to Fri., 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., beginning Wed., Oct. 21, 2020.
