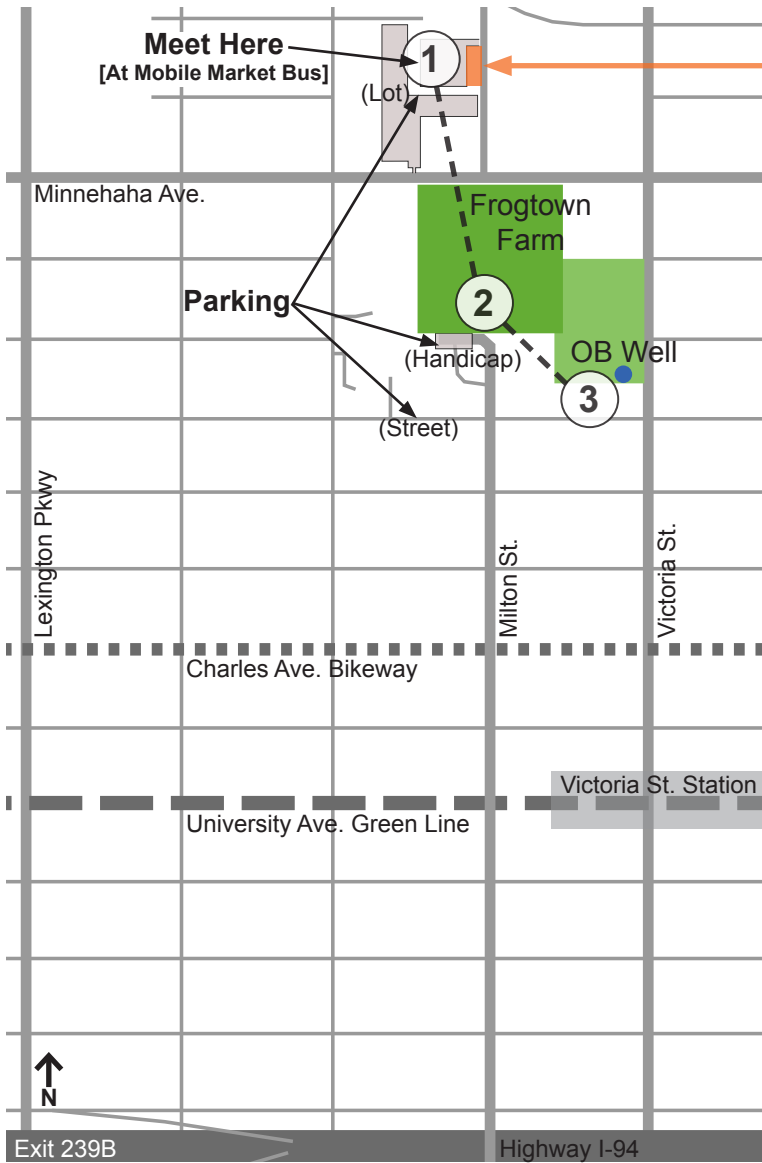
This is a fair weather tour, if the weather turns sour,

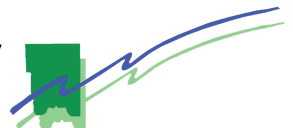
