- 4) 2016 REGIONAL PARKS SYSTEM USE ESTIMATE (Attachment)
 - Jon presented the information from the Met Council's Annual Use Estimate of the Regional Parks System for 2016.
 - Vadnais, Keller, Battle Creek are the top three most visited parks in Ramsey County.
 - Phalen-Keller is number 8 in most visited in the metro, Battle Creek-Indian Mound is 13, Grass-Vadnais-Snail is 20.
 - Ramsey County is 4th overall
 - Walking/Hiking is the most popular activity
- 5) WINTER RECREATION SNOW MAKING PLANS
 - Touring budget office; asking for \$2 million for snowmaking. Making a pitch with the Governor's staff touring the site on September 25th.
 - Working to get a realistic budget for snow-making installation.
- 6) PROPOSED BUDGET (Attachment)
 - Jon shared the County Manager's proposed budget, which is out for public review and comment. The County Board will approve the final budget in December.
 - Budget and funding regarding the ADA Transition Plan was discussed briefly.
 - Overall budget is \$12.8 million. Levy is \$4 million. Revenue is \$8 million.
 - Golf course system study \$200K in 2018 to analyze how our courses are operating and compare with the market the study will provide recommendations.
 - Workers compensation salaries, training and safety team discussed.

Fees, charges and capital will be presented later and are approved separately.

- Proposed by the Wild that Ramsey County handles the scheduling of the new practice facility atop the former Macy's location in Saint Paul.
- Ramsey County would schedule and would have access to prime hours,
 The Wild would have primary access on weekday mornings, not a typical-use time for most county users.
- The Wild would own and operate the rink.
- Concerns around parking downtown. Bringing terms of an agreement to the County Board on September 26.

• Review of proposed Keller practice range to adjust the angle of the tee box, and make ADA improvements to the access and parking lot.

c. LAND ACQUISITION

 Parks acquired a piece of land between 494 and Highway 61 on Point Douglas Road/Mississippi River Trail to supplement the Fish Creek Open Space. Acquired from MNDOT.

d. HIGHLAND RESERVOIR

- Parks has submitted a letter of intent requesting use of the land area that is currently a decommissioned water reservoir.
- Proposed use will be determined by the County Board but could include additional parking and storm water solutions. A Board Workshop on October 3 will provide direction for the proposal.
