Climate Change and Public Health.	 Zack Hansen presented relevant data indicating climate change trends in the U.S. and in the state of MN Robert Einweck followed by highlighting tactical responses for extreme heat events, which are happening more frequently. Nick Ronnei demonstrated the use of a vulnerability assessment/GIS tool to figure out which areas in the County are more at risk when extreme hot (or cold) weather events happen. Healthy Homes	Zack Hansen opened the next segment by introducing Jim- Yannarelly with Healthy Homes Program, and Joan Brandt, who manages the Family Health Division home visiting programs. Together, they tag-team to identify residents, particularly homes with young children who are at risk of lead exposure and asthma. The best approaches to identifying, referring and treating children exposed to lead (i.e. Window replacements) may also be helpful in helping those who are asthmatic.
