Community Mini-grants

With roll-over funds from the previous SHIP grant year, Saint Paul - Ramsey County Public Health offered mini-grants to community organizations. These mini-grants, ranging from \$1,500 to \$3,000, are funding opportunities to help support healthier eating, active living, and tobacco cessation. Approximately 47 applications were received with requests totaling \$109,197. Twenty-two were funded at a total of \$54,450. Projects will begin February 2018 and be completed by June 2018.
