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### Clinic 555, Reproductive and Sexual Health Services

- › Primary Clinic - Located at 555 Cedar Street, Downtown Saint Paul, across from the 10<sup>th</sup> street light rail stop, Juenemann Building.
  - › Demographics/Outreach locations
- Services Offered for Men and Women
- › Family Planning - birth control, clinical examinations
  - › Emergency Contraception
  - › Immunizations
  - › Pregnancy Testing
  - › Sage Program Services- breast exam, cervical screening, mammogram
  - › Sexually Transmitted Infection/HIV Testing, Education and Referral
  - › \*NEW\* Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) and Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (nPEP)

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### What is Title X?

- › Federally funded grant allocation
- › Title X is the only federal grant program dedicated solely to providing individuals with comprehensive family planning and related preventive health services
- › Title X family planning grant funded dollars ensure access to a broad range of family planning and related preventive health services for millions of low-income or uninsured individuals.
- › Saint-Paul Ramsey County Clinic 555 has been a recipient of Title X for 40 plus years.

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### Clinic 555 – Use of Title X funds

- › Staff FTE (Title X pays for a percentage of our staffing costs)
- › Clinical Visits, 100% or below Federal Poverty Level (FPL) cannot be charged a fee for service
- › Family Planning/Birth Control
- › Medications, Treatment of STD/ STI's
- › Laboratory Costs
- › Education/ Training/ Brochures
- › Prevention visits/ Screening cervical cancer, breast exams and mammograms, immunizations, PrEP and nPEP visits
- › Outreach/ Community Engagement

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### What we CANNOT use Title X funds for

- › Lobbying/ Political action of any sort
- › For abortion services and/or as a method of family planning
- › Salary limits are required by law




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Title X requires a yearly work plan that outlines the outcomes and objectives for Clinic 555




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### Work Plan Highlights

- › Outcomes
  - › Prevention of unintended pregnancy
  - › Prevention of teen pregnancy
  - › Promotion of Optimal Birth Spacing
  - › Services and Contraceptive methods are SAFE
  - › Services and Contraceptive methods are EFFECTIVE
  - › Services are CLIENT CENTERED
  - › Services are EFFICIENT
  - › Services are TIMELY
  - › Services are ACCESSIBLE
  - › Services are EQUITABLE
  - › Services are SUSTAINABLE

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### Outcome Example, Year 1

- › Prevention of unintended pregnancy
  - › Objective/ Goal set to increase the number of females who use an FDA approved method of birth control to 80%
- › Services are client centered
  - › Goal set to maintain patient satisfaction rating at 90% overall approval rating or better
- › Services are timely
  - › Goal set to implement 24-48 hour turnover on GC/CT testing, implement same day rapid initial and confirmatory testing for all client types
