Family Planning

Services provided to prevent or plan a pregnancy.

Birth control methods:

- Birth control pills
- The shot (Depo)
- Condoms
- Implant
- IUDs
- The patch
- The ring
- Diaphragm
- Abstinence
- Natural family planning (NFP)

Pregnancy Testing

Urine pregnancy tests are provided as soon as a period is missed.

- No appointment needed
- Same day results
- Pregnancy options counseling offered

Sexually Transmitted Infection & HIV Testing

Services provided for screening, diagnosis and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs).

Diseases:

- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhea
- Herpes, if sore is present
- Syphilis
- Trichomoniasis
- Human papillomavirus (HPV) or genital warts
- HIV - testing and counseling

Symptoms to watch for:

- Unusual discharge
- Genital sores, bumps, blisters or itching
- Pelvic pain or burning
- Irregular bleeding
- Pain during sex
- Pain with urination
- Some STIs may be present with no symptoms

Services may include:

- Education and counseling
- Partner treatment
- Referrals

Emergency Contraception

Prevents pregnancy up to five days (120 hours) after unprotected sex or birth control failure.

- No appointment needed
- Brief medical consultation
- Exam not required in most cases

PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis)

An HIV prevention option that works by taking one pill every day.

- Initial PrEP education and counseling
- Financial assistance, if needed
- Three month follow-up appointments

Additional Services

- Annual gynecological exams, which may include Pap smear
- Free breast and cervical cancer screening for eligible women:
 - ◆ Cervical exam for women 21 and older
 - ◆ Mammogram referral for women 40 and older
- Vaccines (when needed)
