Our Purpose:

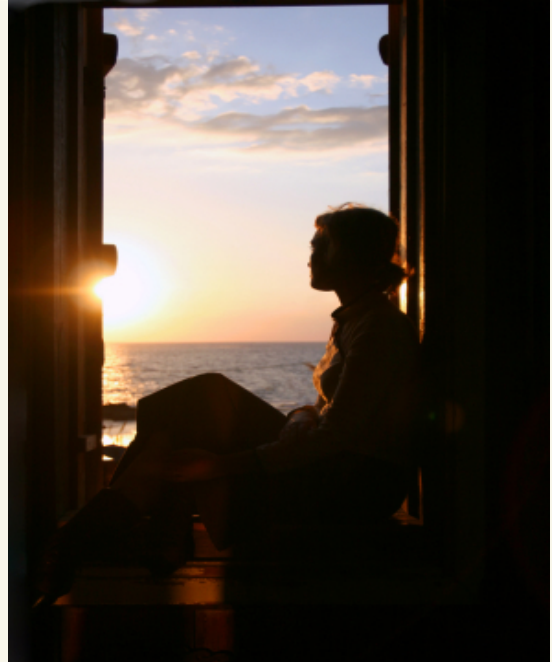

- Make specific recommendations relating to the development/modification of the chemical health service delivery system
- Annual review of vulnerable adult reports
- Plan and administer training events
- Special assignments from the County Board and CAC
