This rule requires that the following items be removed two days prior to demolition: mixed municipal solid waste; household hazardous waste; industrial or hazardous waste; waste tires; major appliances; items containing elemental mercury, Poly-Chlorinated BiPhenyls (PCBs), and chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs); oil; lead; electronics; and other prohibited items.
