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WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes §473.851 – 473.871 require local governmental units in the Twin Cities Metropolitan Area to review and update their comprehensive plans, including fiscal devices and official controls, at least once every ten years to ensure comprehensive plans conform to metropolitan system plans; and

WHEREAS, The comprehensive plans currently under review are based on the Metropolitan Council's 2030 Regional Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Ramsey County Board of Commissioners approved its last comprehensive plan on December 17, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Ramsey County has been in the process of updating its comprehensive plan for 2030; and

WHEREAS, The County has followed all of the requirements set forth by the Metropolitan Council in the development and review of the Comprehensive Plan Update ("Plan"), including all government entities within Ramsey County being given a six-month period to review and comment on the Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Minnesota Statutes require county governments to adopt their comprehensive plans by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Ramsey County Home Rule Charter states that every proposed Ordinance shall receive two readings: first, at the time it is presented, and second, at the time of the public hearing, before taking action; and

WHEREAS, All necessary requirements have been fulfilled; Now, Therefore, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Ramsey Does

ORDAIN, That the Ramsey County 2030 Comprehensive Plan is hereby adopted.
