Introduce New Education Manager at Tamarack Nature Center (TNC)

Mark introduced Noelle Roden and her history with Tamarack Nature Center.

Noelle introduced the members to Tamarack Nature Center; its history, mission as well as a programing overview and education amenities the center provides. One major accomplishment is that TNC has an agreement with Saint Paul Public Schools which funds a field trip to TNC for all pre-K students. TNC also serves as White Bear Lake Townships Pre-K school.

Nature Center Grounds Tour: Highlights

- No Charge for entry or parking.
- Hundreds of pounds of garden produce is given to the White Bear Lake Food Shelf annually.
- Discovery Hollow has lots of climbing spaces and a water play feature.
- Visited the new Sugar Shack.
 - Build by Parks & Recreation Staff which saved money and produced a custom building.
 - o Maple syrup is given to volunteers and used for the annual Volunteer Pancake Feast.
- The Nature center has several animal exhibits two favorites are the threatened Blanding's Turtle and the Apiary.

Noelle asked for feedback/ideas on how to increase user diversity and programing. Some suggestions were:

- Connecting with the libraries for shuttle services.
- Connect with Saint Paul Community centers as a pickup location.
- Work to increase volunteer diversity so that diverse groups can see someone that looks like them.
- Encourage partnerships with Scouting groups.
- Reference the Lake Nokomis Monarch Festival.
