

Battle Creek Sewer Construction

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services is undertaking a rehabilitation project for the Battle Creek regional sewer (interceptor) system in Saint Paul.

Need for this work:

MCES staff identified numerous system issues requiring corrective action, including severe corrosion and voids or breaks in the piping

Project benefits:

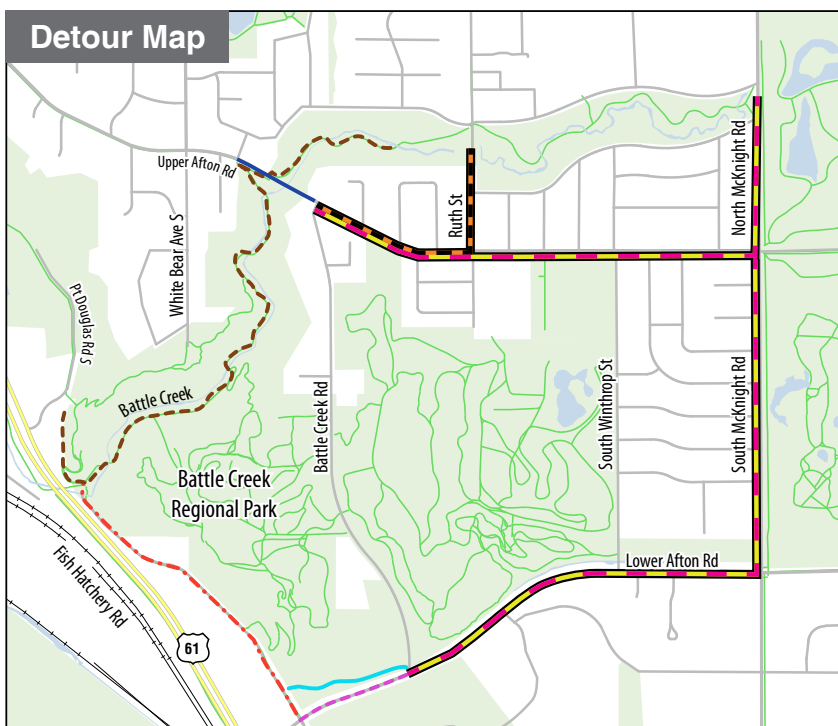
- Reduce infiltration and inflow (groundwater that enters and overloads the wastewater system, causing backups into rivers, lakes, and buildings)
- Rehabilitate deteriorated areas to prevent structural and conveyance issues

Work includes:

- Sewer lining: cured-in-place pipe involves the construction of a new pipe inside of the existing pipe
- Manhole replacement
- Operational and safety improvements

Construction:

- Fall 2020 - Fall 2021
- Construction will include trail closures and detours, and temporary limitations to park use
- Impacts may include dust, noise, odors, vibrations, traffic disruptions, equipment staging and visual impacts
