



NOTE: Enhanced access points should also consider additional wayfinding signage to complement physical access points

Explore the possibility of road underpasses to connect trail segments without crossing the road at Upper Afton Road and Ruth Street North.

Ramsey County Public Works will be converting McKnight Road from 4 lanes to 3 and as a part of the project will be installing pedestrian refuges and other enhanced crossing elements at 3 locations:

- Villages on McKnight Crossing
- Edgebrook Avenue
- Hillsdale Avenue

Explore the possibility of road overpasses or other enhanced trail connections of Battle Creek Road to better connect Battle Creek West and the Winter Recreation areas of Battle Creek Regional Park

Typical road crossing enhancements may include:

- Creative crossing painting schematic to stand out
- Rapid Flashing Beacons
- Additional signage

Explore the possibility of road overpass or other enhanced crossing along Lower Afton Road at Burlington Avenue or another location to aid in connecting neighborhoods to the south of the park

Battle Creek Regional Park concept graphics show potential future access points and recreational amenities within Battle Creek Regional Park based on public input. Ramsey County acknowledges that issues including environmental contamination and clean up, public safety, and compatibility of recreational use with surrounding land use must be resolved before any new visitor access or recreational amenities can be provided.
