Point Douglass Regional Trail Search Corridor:

Improve in park bridges to allow for winter snow plowing and recreational use

Accessible trail linking parking lots to off leash dog area may or may not be paved but every effort should be made to ensure safe access into the OLDA in accordance with the Off Leash Dog Areas Master Plan. Other improvements to follow the off leash dog area to follow the Off Leash Dog Areas Master Plan.

Development of the Winter Recreation Area should be a plan priority. The winter recreation area will include:

- Snow Making
- Lighting

Many community members expressed the desire to continue to hike and snowshoe in the winter. In addition to the walking and hiking trails in the bluffs area, care should be taken to allow for a path to the side of cross country ski trails for other winter recreation uses.
