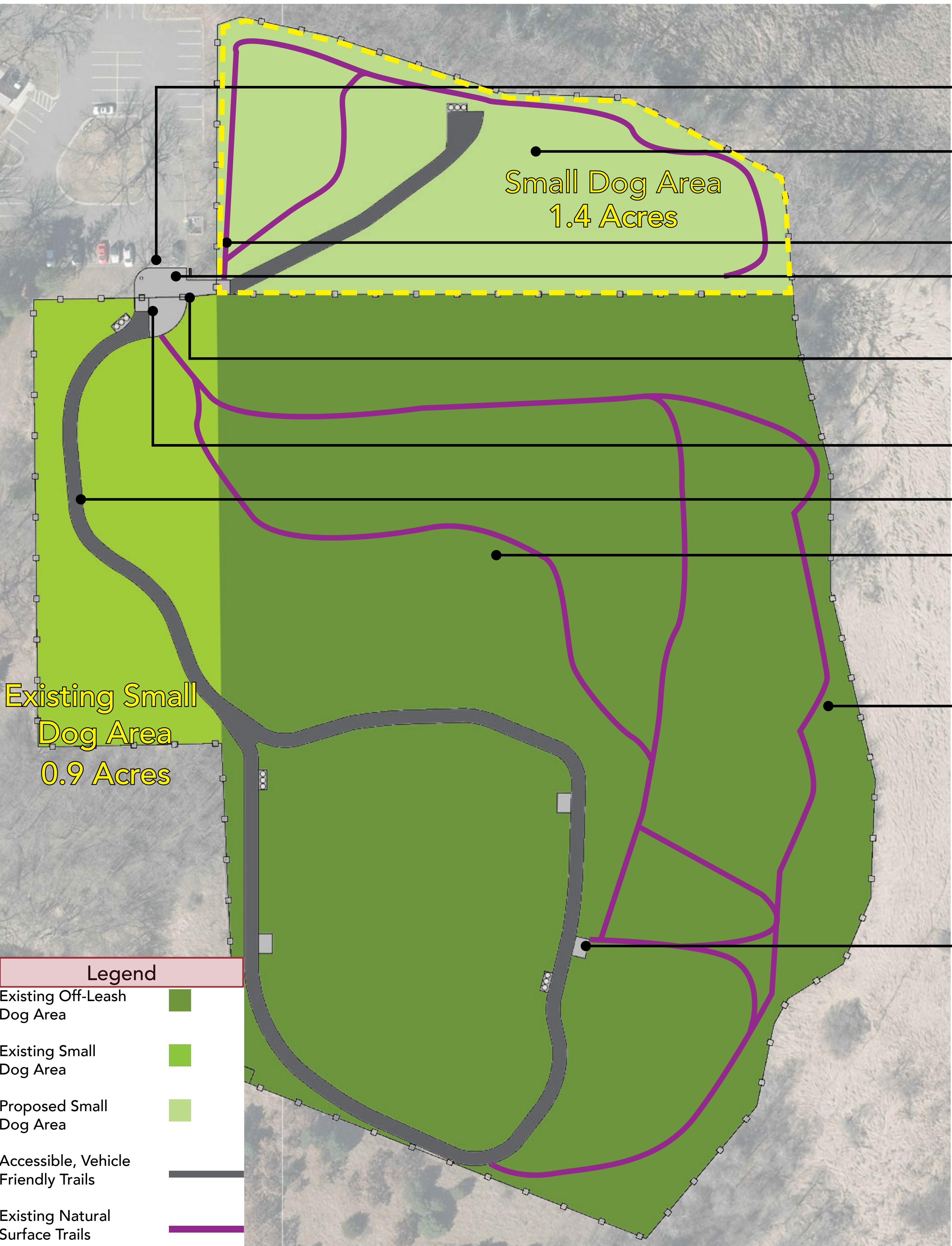


Bald Eagle - Otter Lake OLDA

Future Phases: Potential Future Relocation Fully Fenced, Accessible Small Dog Area

Future Phases: Off Leash Dog Area Rules Board and Bulletin Board at Each Entrance, Typical

Future Phases: Drinking Fountain with Bottle Filler and Pet Bowl

NOTE: Small dog area is proposed to be relocated in the future to provide accessible route to both areas. This provides a safe route through and into both while preventing any wetlands impacts that would occur with the existing layout. The new layout also increases the size to be roughly the same as the other two regionally sized OLDA's.

Phase I Improvements include accessible entrance improvements including entrance paving and concrete work for accessibility, double gated fencing for both OLDA areas and installing sleeves for a future drinking fountain with a bottle filler and pet bowl.
