

#### Trail connections and safety improvements

- Create a new pedestrian connection along Maryland Avenue within the park
- Lower trail improvements include safety lighting and widening of trail
- Outdoor educational (These areas would likely have education information and could be used for potential programming nodes) with birdwatching and educational plaques in multiple languages
- Vegetation management for clearer site views
- Benches and lookouts
- Water access and small natural fishing areas
- Additional smaller parking lots could be added to the northeast corner near the intersection of McKnight and Maryland Ave. We could also have bumpout parking located along the north edge of the park along Maryland

#### The final design will be mindful of the community needs, security and safety, noise management, visibility to the lake edges. Here are a few themes that came out of our community engagement:

- Cultural open space
- welcoming wayfinding around the park in multiple languages
- Sustainable and ecological improvements through vegetation restoration and green power
- Safety and crime
- Vegetation management for clearer site views
- Fishing and lake improvement
- Amenities such as a reserveable shelter with updated restrooms, small locker areas, open area could host a range of turf games, volleyball, winter activities, and cultural games such as Tuj Lub.

See the concept plans for a range of new strategies to increase usability, safety, and inclusivity in Beaver Lake County Park. There are two themes that represent comments heard within existing engagement for consideration of the final master plan.

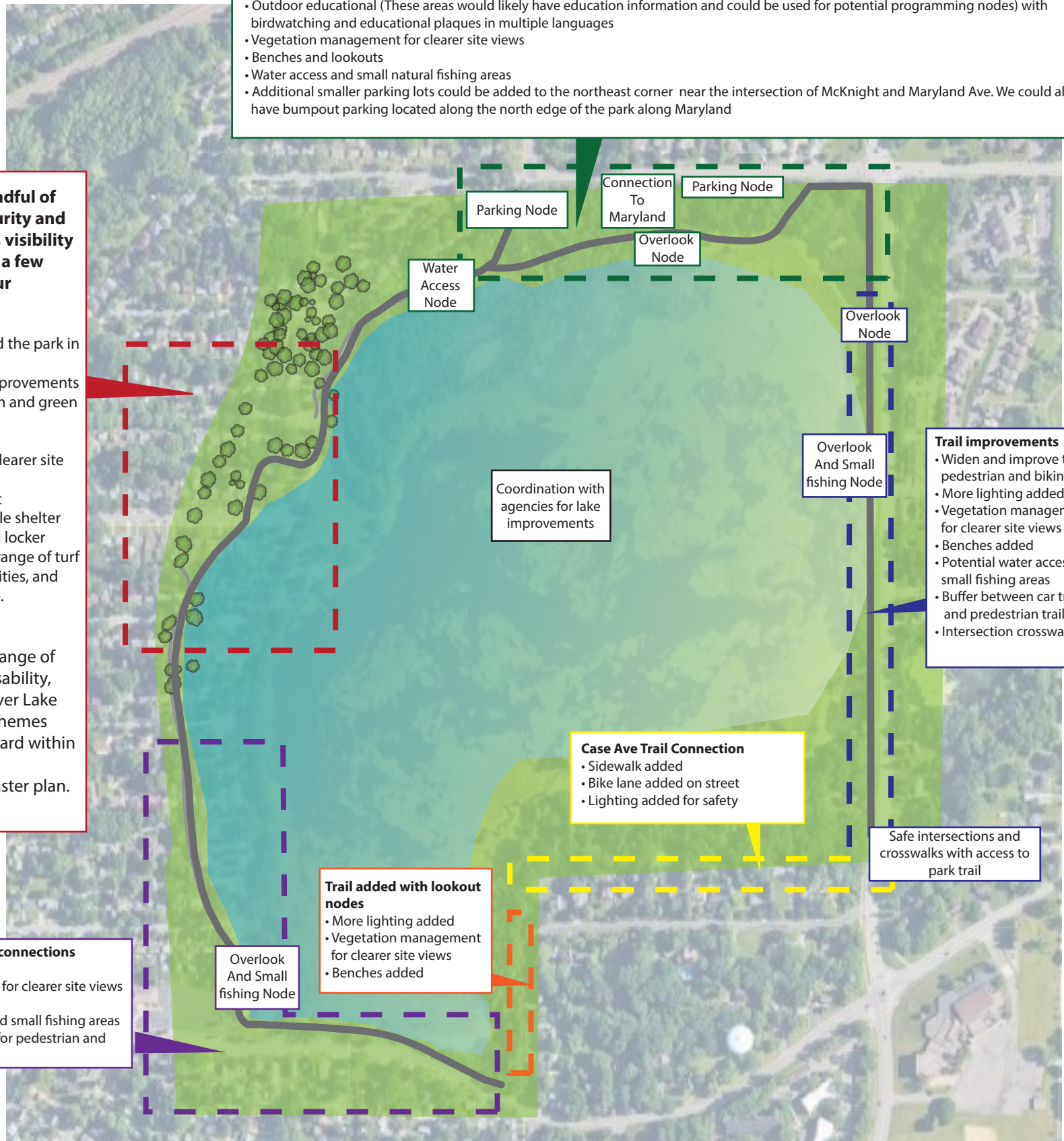
