Project staff will be available throughout the open house for questions and conversation and light refreshments will be provided. There will be no formal presentation.

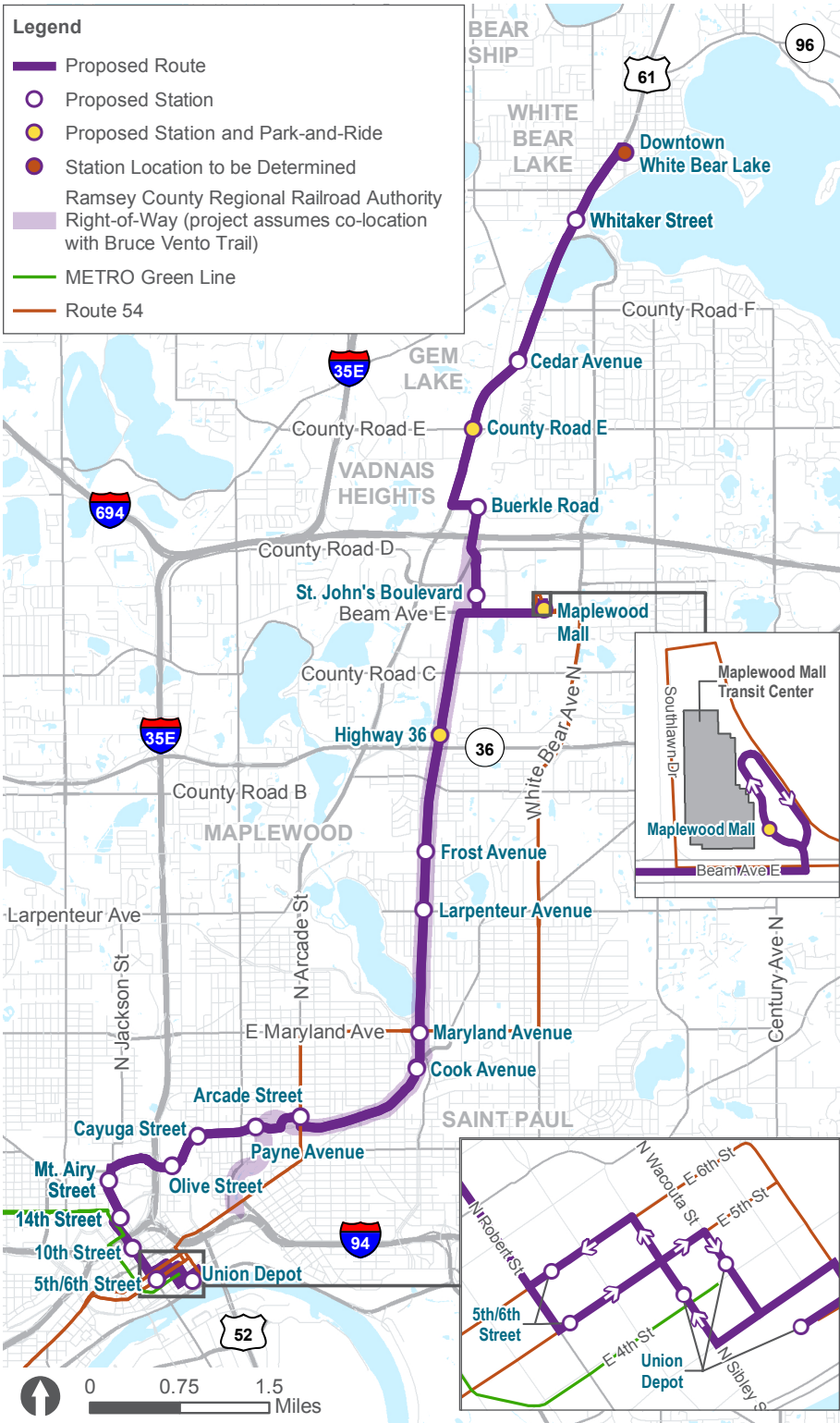

The Rush Line BRT Project is a proposed 14-mile transit route led by Ramsey County with stops between Union Depot in downtown Saint Paul and downtown White Bear Lake; five of these station stops will serve White Bear Lake.

Join project staff at an open house to learn about the Rush Line BRT Project, the importance of Rush Line BRT and the five stops in White Bear Lake, and provide input on potential station locations in downtown White Bear Lake.

BRT is a form of transit service featuring modern, state-of-the-art buses that travel in dedicated lanes, serving well-lit stations with amenities such as heating, fare payment machines and real-time departure information.



The Rush Line BRT Project includes further exploration of connector bus service north to Forest Lake, along with other transit system improvements.
