Mandated Reporter

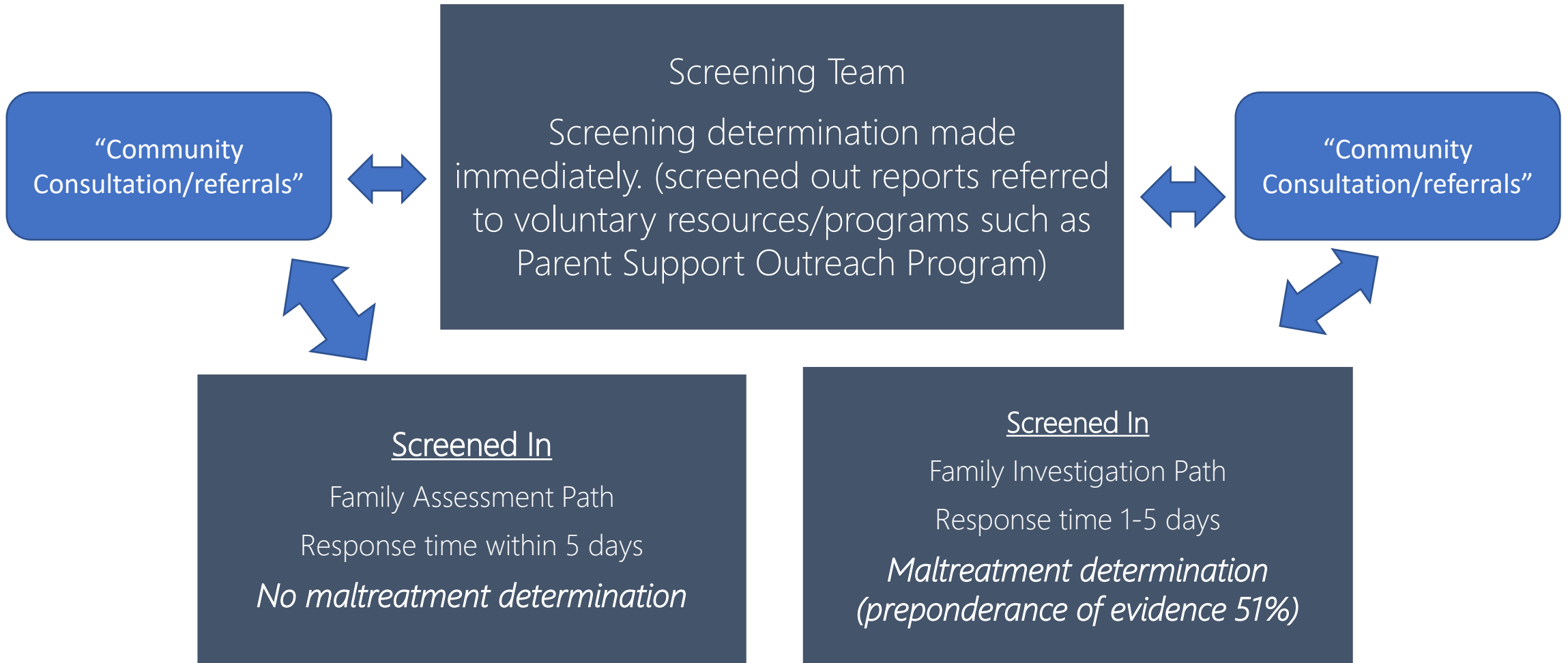

Family Assessments

Reports not involving substantial child endangerment, sexual abuse, or egregious harm



Examples can include;

- Marijuana/substance abuse by parent/caretaker **if** it affects their ability to care for the child
- Supervision concerns (minor)
- Minor physical abuse

All family assessments are assigned a
5-day response time

Family Investigations

Designed to respond to most serious reports of harm/neglect to children



Examples can include;

- Sexual abuse
- Child fatalities or near fatalities
- DWI with child in vehicle
- Significant physical abuse
- Previous termination of parental rights

All investigations are assigned a 24 hour or 5-day response time
