# How it used to be

- Public assistant reimbursement
- Child support based on AFDC grant or estimates
- Large past support debts
- > Hard to reach worker
- Lost your job? Go to court

# What's different

- More money to families
- Automatic income withholding
- Child support based on ability to pay, actual earnings
- Focus on customer service
- Ability to write off some debt

- We've added roles to focus on outreach, racial disparities, improving policies to better serve families
