- Develop ways to reduce the number of people on probation.
- Build coordination across Ramsey County departments and with community-led organizations to support client social and basic needs.
- Develop guidelines that reduce the use and duration of incarceration.

## We're looking for Ramsey County residents with these backgrounds:

- Age 18 and older, with personal experience on probation.
- Preference will be given to those with Ramsey County Community Corrections probation experience.

## Expected time commitment:

- Two in-person meetings a month, 1-2 hours each.
- Community members will receive \$25/hour in the form of a VISA gift card for each meeting.
