## ITEMS ACCEPTED



Blister packs.



Capsules and pills.

EpiPens (unused).



Inhalers.



IV bags.



Liquids.



Patches.



Powders.

Syringes (full and capped).



Vials.

## ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- **NO** empty needles or syringes. Bring them to a household hazardous waste collection site.
- **NO** uncapped needles or syringes.
- **NO** liquid chemo drugs. Bring them back to your clinic.
- **NO** medicine from businesses. This includes healthcare facilities, long-term care facilities, pharmacies, doctors' offices and veterinary clinics.
