

- **NO** items with freon, including A/C units, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, etc.
- NO large or small appliances, including microwaves.
- NO light bulbs/lamps, including fluorescent tubes, CFLs, LED and incandescent lights.\*
- NO loose batteries.
