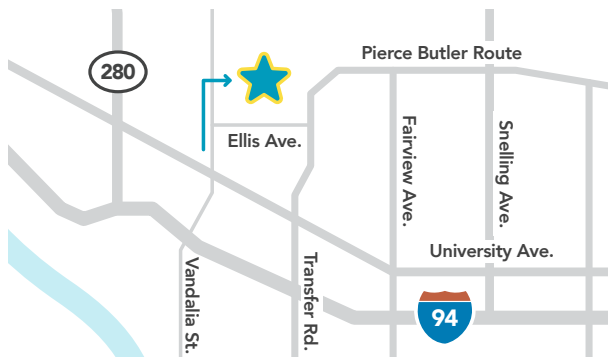
Drop off unwanted electronics for free.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- **NO** car parts, power tools or solar panels.
- **NO** hazardous waste, including aerosols, paint, chemicals, radioactive materials, etc.*
- **NO** holiday string lights.*
- **NO** items with freon, including A/C units, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, etc.
- **NO** large or small appliances, including microwaves.
- **NO** light bulbs/lamps, including fluorescent tubes, CFLs, LED and incandescent lights.*
- **NO** loose batteries.
- **NO** business waste. Businesses can visit getrepowered.org for options.
