FREE Disposal of Needles & Syringes

Safe disposal of needles, syringes and lancets prevents injury and disease transmission. Ramsey County only accepts sharps at the year-round household hazardous waste collection site.

Year-Round Collection Site Hours



December - March

Fri: 11am–6pm
Sat: 9am–4pm

April - October

Tues–Fri: 11am–6pm
Sat: 9am–4pm

November

Thurs–Fri: 11am–6pm
Sat: 9am–4pm

(Closed: New Years,
Thanksgiving, and
Christmas)

Guidelines:

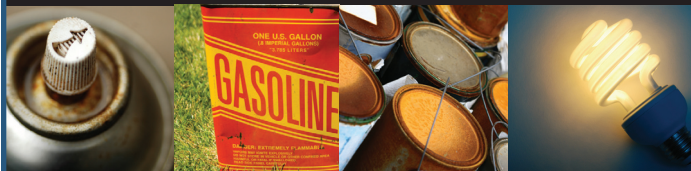
- Empty syringes of any liquid.
- Put syringe (needle side down) into a hard sided container like a laundry detergent jug.
- Seal the container and label it “Sharps.”
- Inform staff at site that you have sharps to drop off and place them in the collection box.

Loose sharps are not accepted. No business waste.

FREE disposal of Household Hazardous Waste

Accepted Materials (examples)

Home Improvement

Paint, thinners, solvents, adhesives, driveway sealant, wood preservatives and stains, lead paint chips, aerosol cans

Automotive Products

Used oil & filters, brake fluid, gasoline, antifreeze, auto batteries (keep all automotive fluids separate)

Items with Mercury

Thermometers, fluorescent lights, switches, thermostats, vapor lamps

Cleaning Products

Drain opener, oven cleaner, bathroom cleaner, rust remover

Recreational Products

Rechargeable batteries, button batteries, lithium batteries, propane tanks, pool chemicals, gas cylinders

Lawn & Garden Chemicals

Weed killer, insecticides, pesticides

No business waste.
