

Open House Comment Cards (27)

Comment

Fully support roundabouts at all intersections. Fully support 35E NB and 35E SB (to Ash St.) access.

Extend noise wall north to curb noise level at end of merge ramp and where 3 lanes go to 2.

I live on Otter Lake Road and am concerned about the amount of traffic along there. It makes it dangerous to walk our dog or go for a bike ride. It seems this plan will increase traffic. Otter Lake is part of a designated Ramsey County parkway. I would prefer to see it addressed more a park. I oppose the roundabout on Otter Lake Rd. I'm on with the one near the theater.

Concerned about increased traffic on Otter View Trail during construction. Would like to see traffic stops added.

- 1) Concerned about the added traffic may hit Otter View Trail during construction period.
- 2) Speed limits not obeyed now how can we be assured that speed limit will be enforced?

Great project. Love the roundabouts. Looks like project has been well studied and vetted

It appears that there was no consideration for the people that live close to the new roundabout intersections. I live 2 houses from Centerville Rd on J. I currently can wait 10 minutes to get out of my driveway - I was told that won't change. I believe it will be worse once there is a constant flow of traffic with no stop sign. Put in a 3 way.

Please help us slow down traffic coming off the hwy going southbound on Otter Lake Rd. People want to walk and bike along the lake and we fear vehicles won't slow down exiting the roundabout. There are also children we live and play in these yards, along with a dog park people try to walk to.

I think it is very unsafe to include crosswalks in a roundabout situation. Most people during rush hour are more interested in merging into a roundabout and not always aware of walkers or bikers. This would make the whole roundabout more prone to congestion. It would make more sense to have a walking /biking trail on one side of the roundabout where people would have to STOP.

The "wall" that was put up on east side of 35E between H2 and County Rd J. For us being on the west side of 35E, the noise is bouncing off that wall is much louder now. Would like to see a sound barrier wall on the west side also. Thanks.

Long overdue - great project

Add meter light on northbound exit to Co J during afternoon rush hour (like on south entrance in morning)

No north and southbound 35E lanes

No roundabouts

Keep traffic lights

I much prefer concept 1. It seems that it will do a good job of keeping moving; we won't have to waste gas waiting for a light to turn especially when there is no traffic on the green light also, does not require energy.

I've said it before - Anoka County needs access where the housing has been built. A bridge and access at that Lake Rd across to Birch Rd. Put the access where it is needed.

- 2) Will my front yard be affected (land taken) on the west side of road or the lake side?
- 3) Invasive lighting around the roundabout?
