

# Pennsylvania Avenue Reconstruction



## OVERVIEW

Ramsey County, in cooperation with the City of St. Paul, is developing preliminary design concepts for the reconstruction of Pennsylvania Avenue between Rice Street and Mississippi Street.

The Pennsylvania Avenue Reconstruction Project aims to study existing conditions, engage the community, develop a future vision, and identify a preferred design layout for the corridor.

## GOALS

- Balance freight, vehicular and multimodal traffic needs by prioritizing safety, accessibility and convenience.
- Ensure transportation improvements benefit all segments of the population.
- Coordinate with local jurisdictions and agencies regarding ongoing, programmed and future projects.
- Identify a preferred design layout to move into final design for reconstruction in 2029.

## TIMELINE

### WINTER/SPRING 2025

- Begin community engagement and encourage public input
- Analyze existing traffic conditions
- Begin preliminary concept development

### SUMMER/FALL 2025

- Continue **connecting with the community** on preliminary concepts
- Alternative analysis and evaluation

Construction on Jackson St. from University Ave. to Pennsylvania Ave.

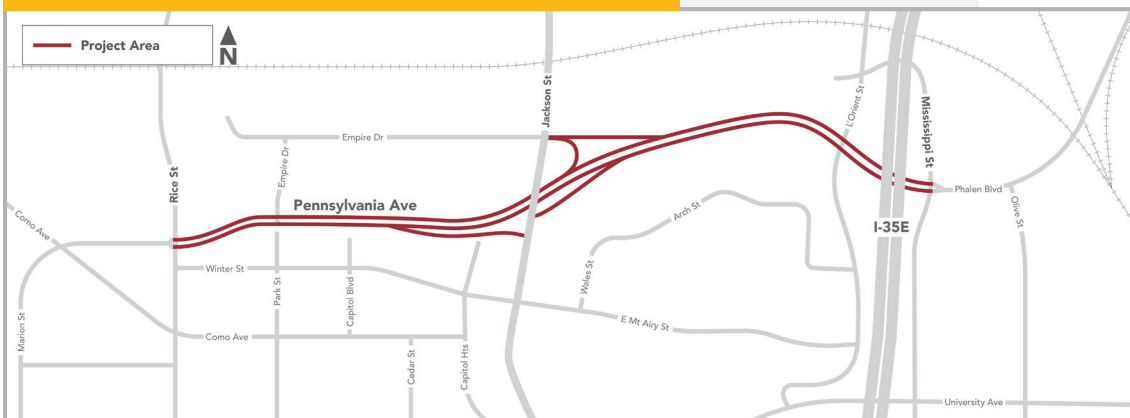
### APRIL–NOV 2026
