

PROJECT PURPOSE AND GOALS



Improve transit connections to jobs, education, health care, recreational areas, activity centers, and the regional and national transportation network.



Support, protect and enhance corridor resources, neighborhoods, businesses, and the Mississippi and Minnesota Rivers.



Improve multimodal transportation facilities in the corridor to support community health.



Support sustainable development and employment that advances applicable plans and policies.



Develop a cost-competitive project with local and regional support.

PROJECT DESIGN PRIORITIES

The Riverview Corridor Modern Streetcar's project team is working with the City of Saint Paul, Metro Transit, MnDOT and other stakeholders to develop a modern streetcar that meets shared priorities, which include:



Convenient, reliable, accessible and frequent service.



Complements existing transit service with convenient connections.



Serve highest volume of customers.



Prioritize efficient operations.



Connect neighborhoods and key destinations to Union Depot.



Accessible station areas with many high-end amenities.



Minimize and mitigate property impacts for residents and businesses.



Improve safety for bikes and pedestrians.

UNION DEPOT - A HUB FOR CONNECTIONS



The Riverview Corridor Modern Streetcar's route will connect with multi-modal transportation options at or near Union Depot. These connections include:

- Metro Transit: Local and suburban bus routes, and Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) services.
- LRT: Metro Transit Green Line.
- Intercity Bus: Jefferson Lines, Greyhound and Megabus.
- Intercity Passenger Rail: Amtrak.
