Survey Overview

Ramsey County and the City of Saint Paul are working to improve transit service along West 7th Street between downtown Saint Paul, the Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport, and the Mall of America.

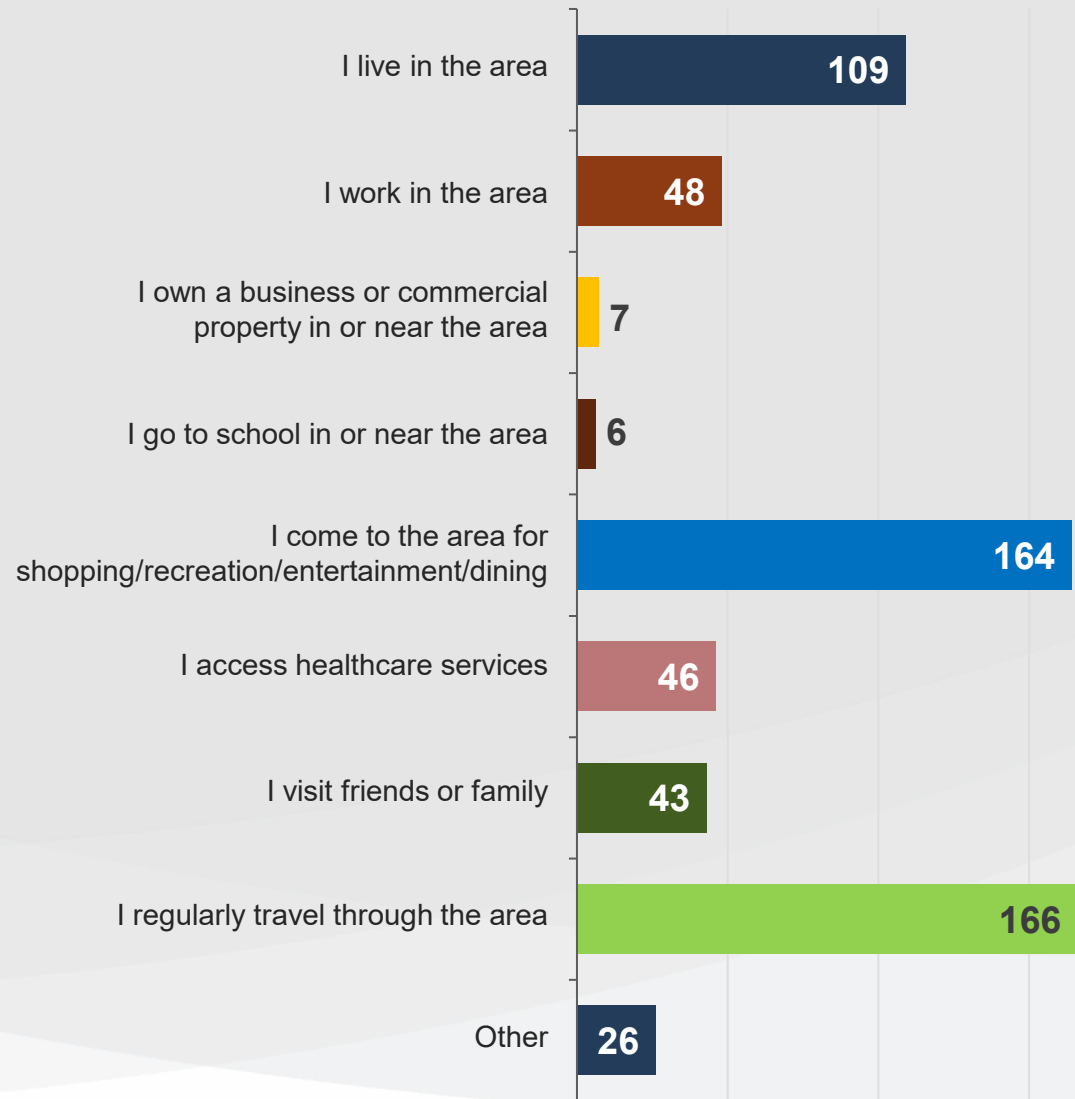


Survey Overview

The Riverview Corridor Station Area Planning Survey was made available to the public and focused on the neighborhoods surrounding two planned transit stations at Grand Avenue and Kellogg Boulevard. Valuable input from the community will help inform and create plans to guide future growth and development at transit stops along West 7th. While open to the public, the survey collected a total of 285 responses with a 67% completion rate.

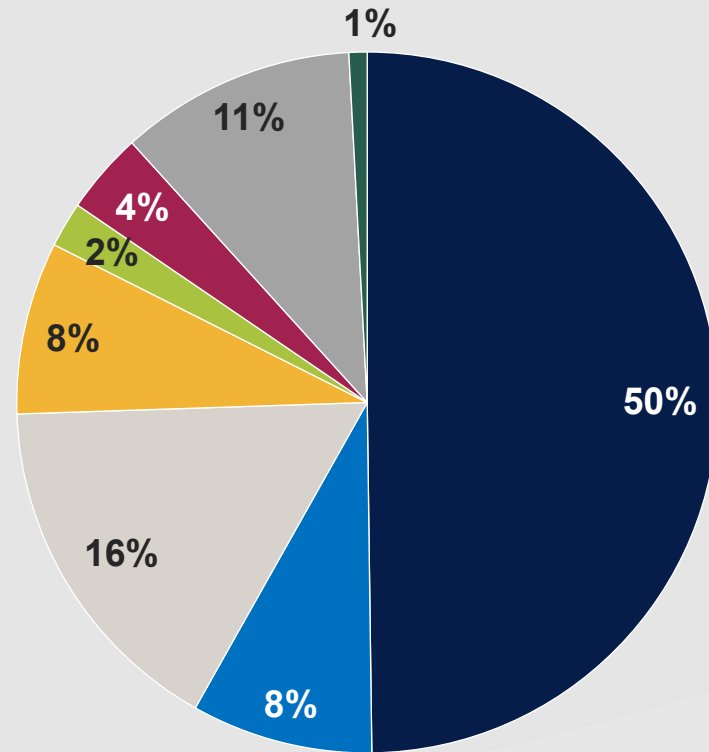

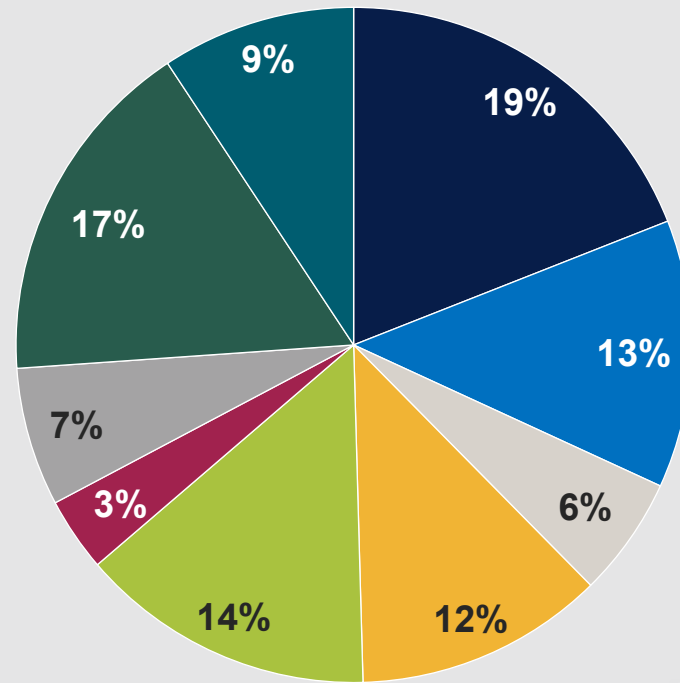

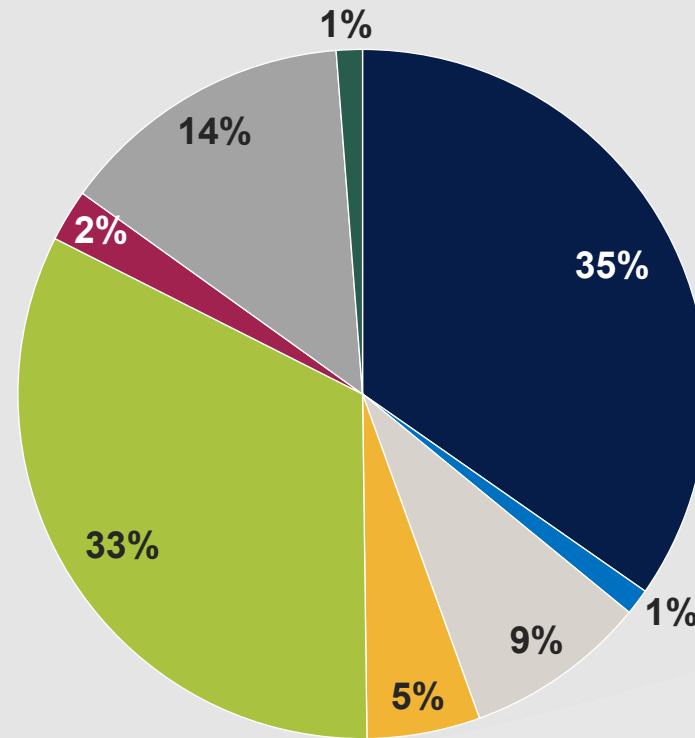

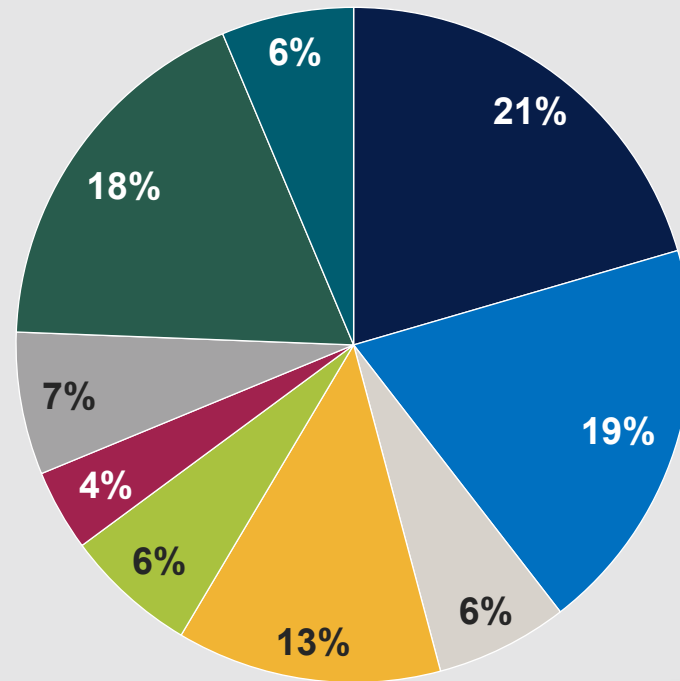

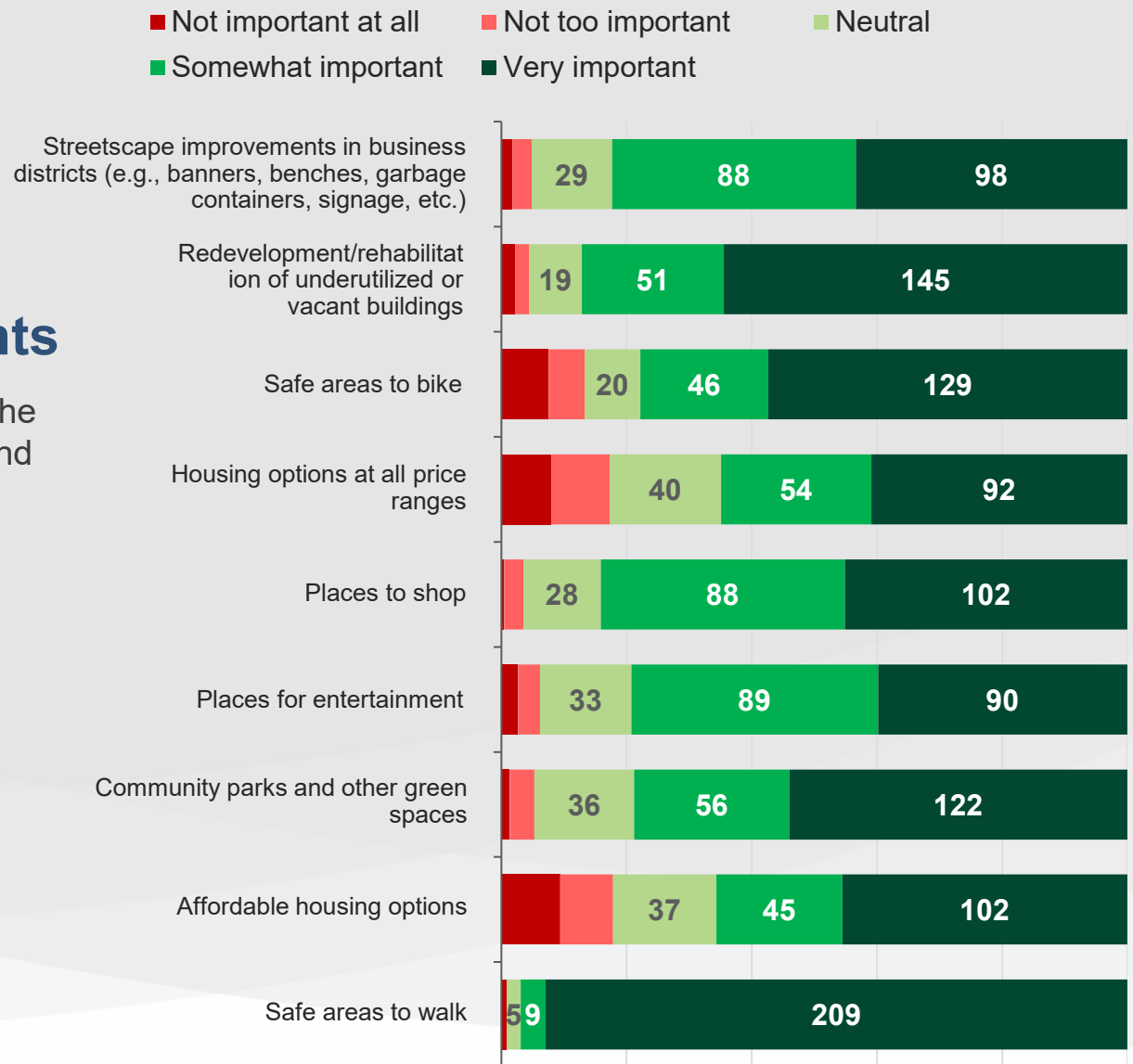

How important do you consider the following to the future of the Grand and Kellogg station areas?

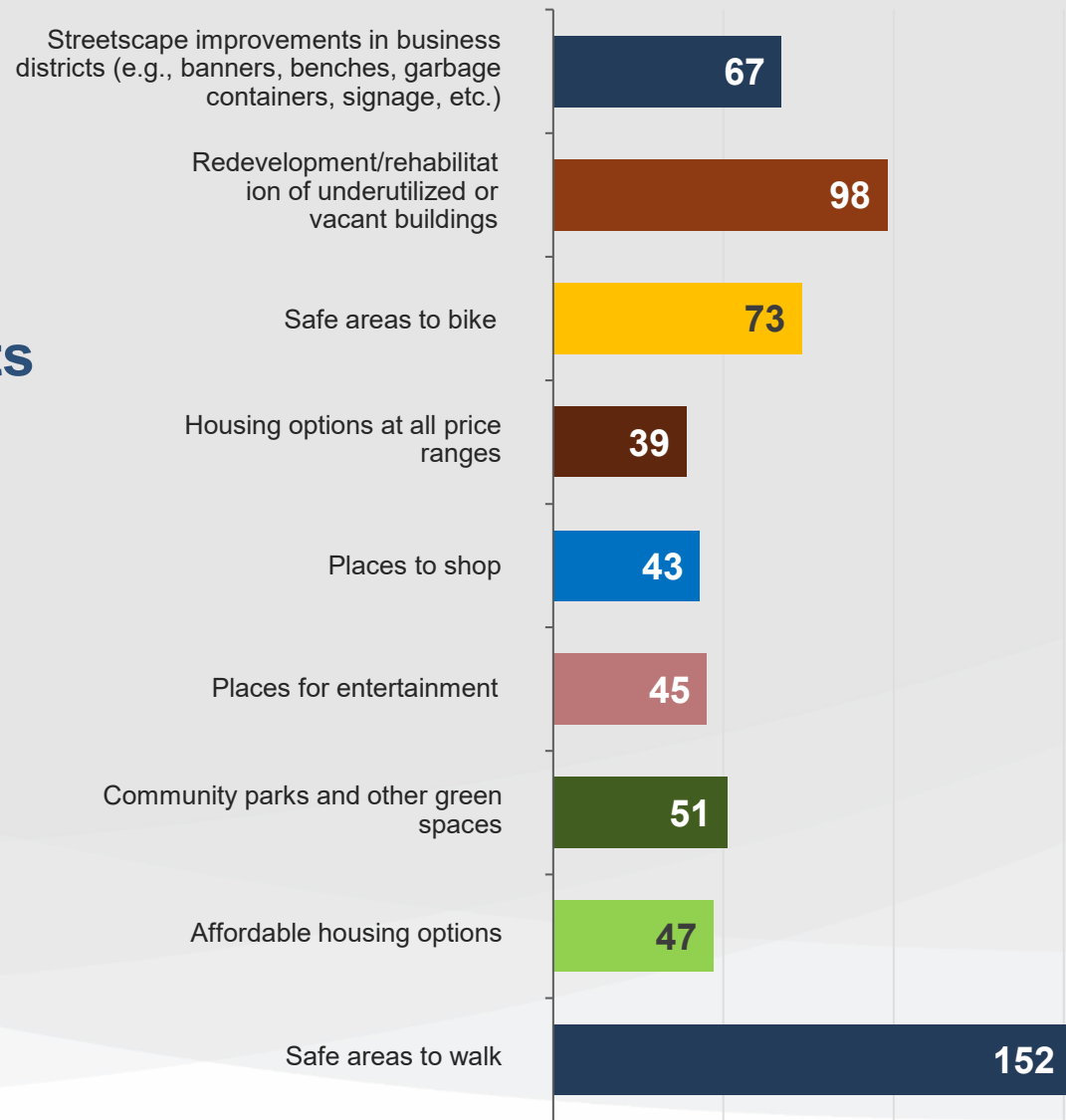


Prioritizing Key Community Elements

People need to get around without having to drive

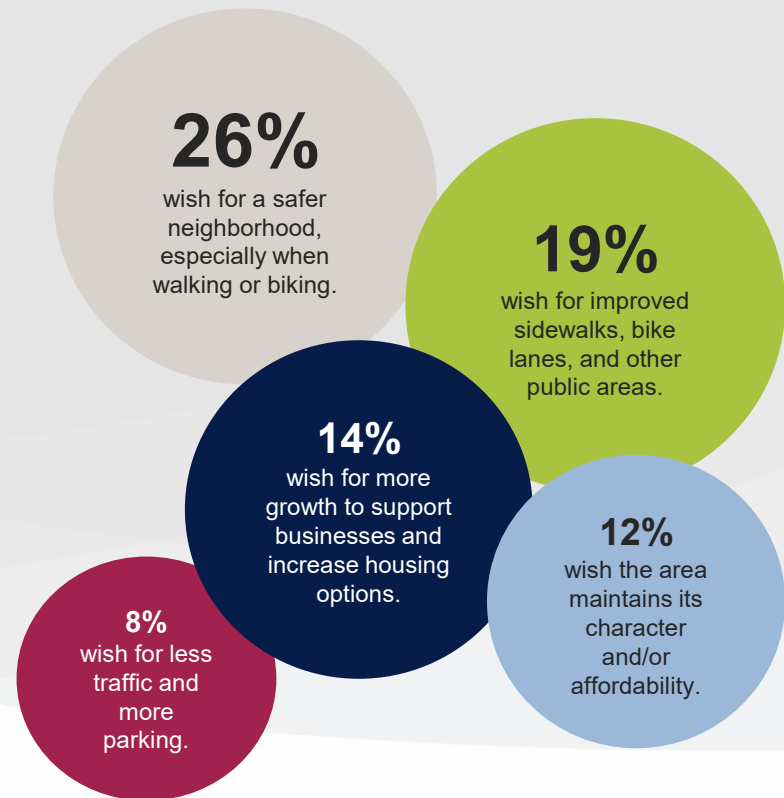

Access to the river and surrounding neighborhoods

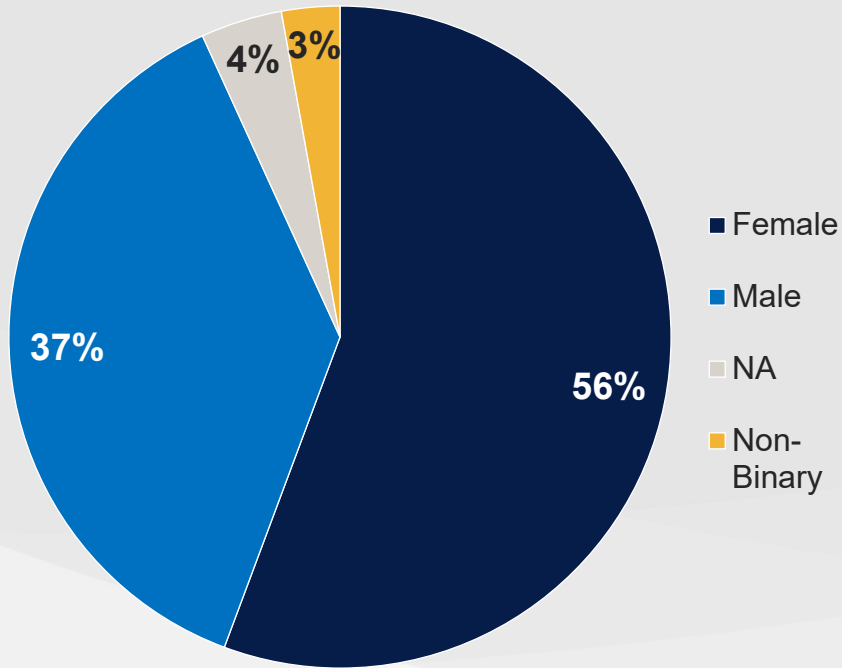
Include plans for **public safety** and **crime prevention**

The transit needs to be on **dedicated lanes**

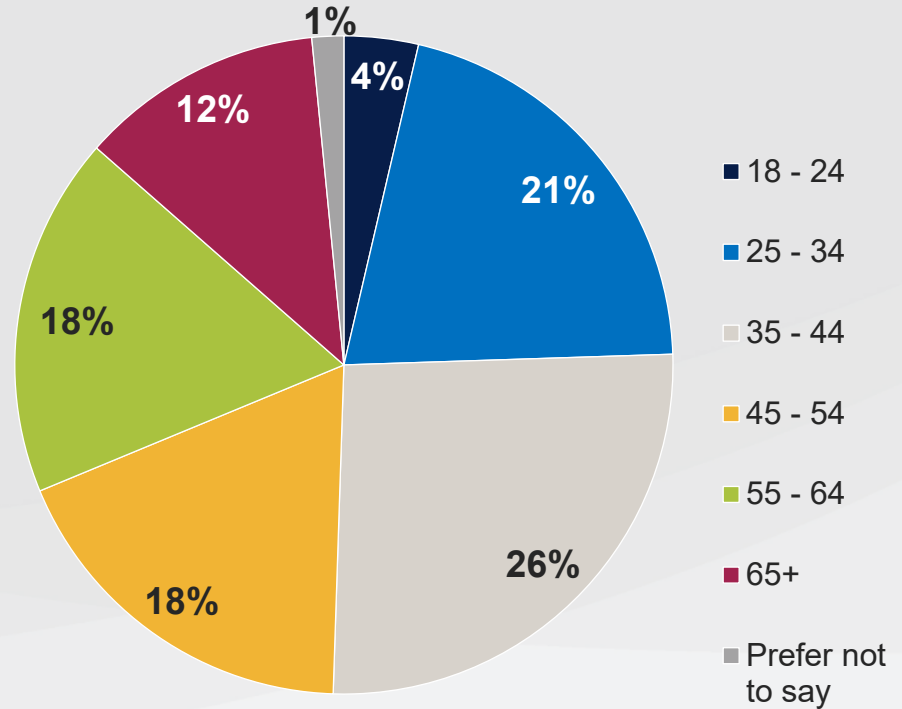
Develop efficient and safe **ped/bike infrastructure**

With which gender do you most closely identify?

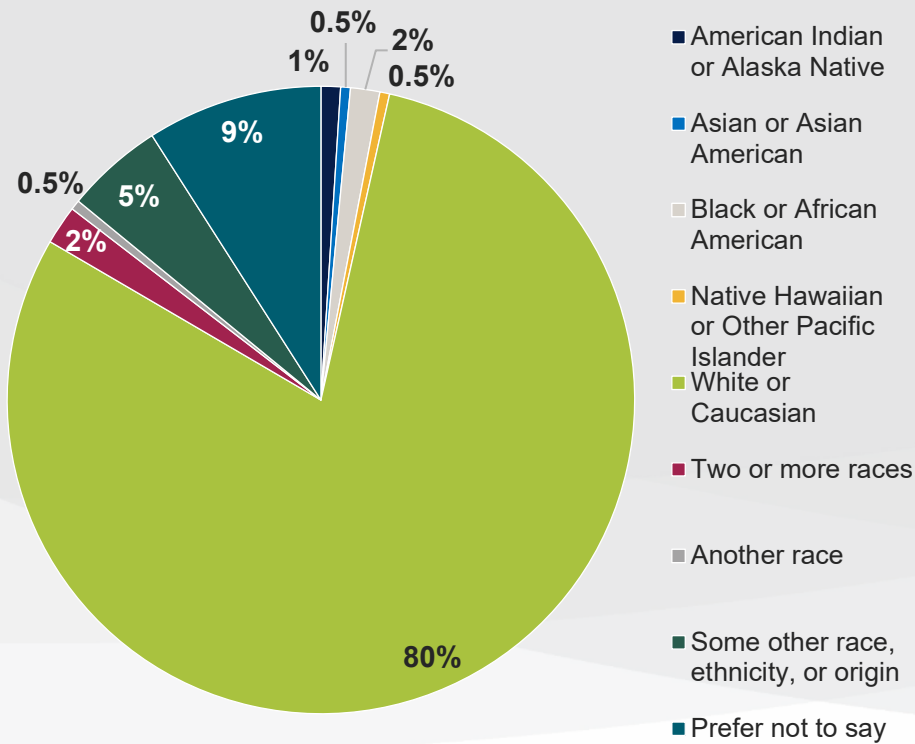


What is your age?

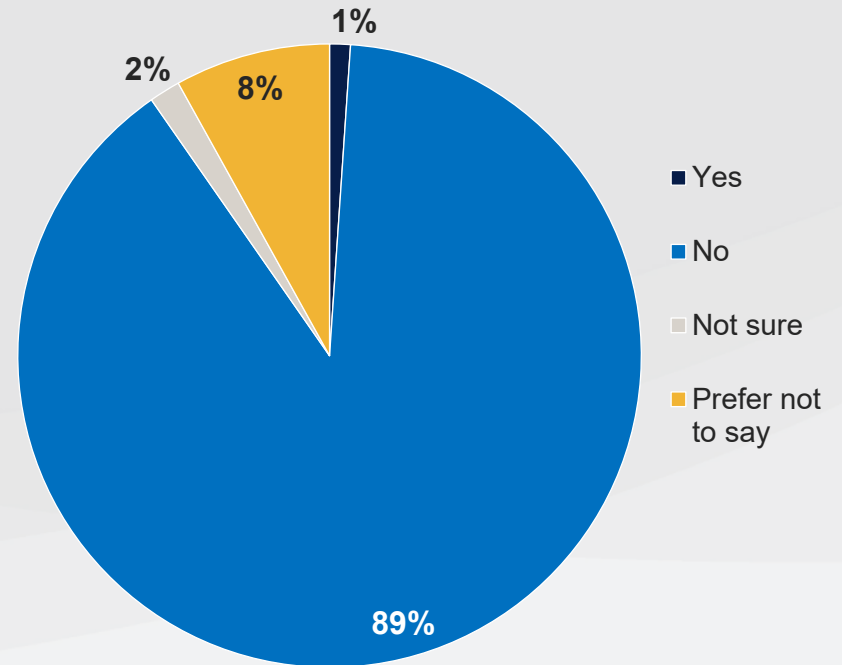

Which of the following races do you most closely identify?

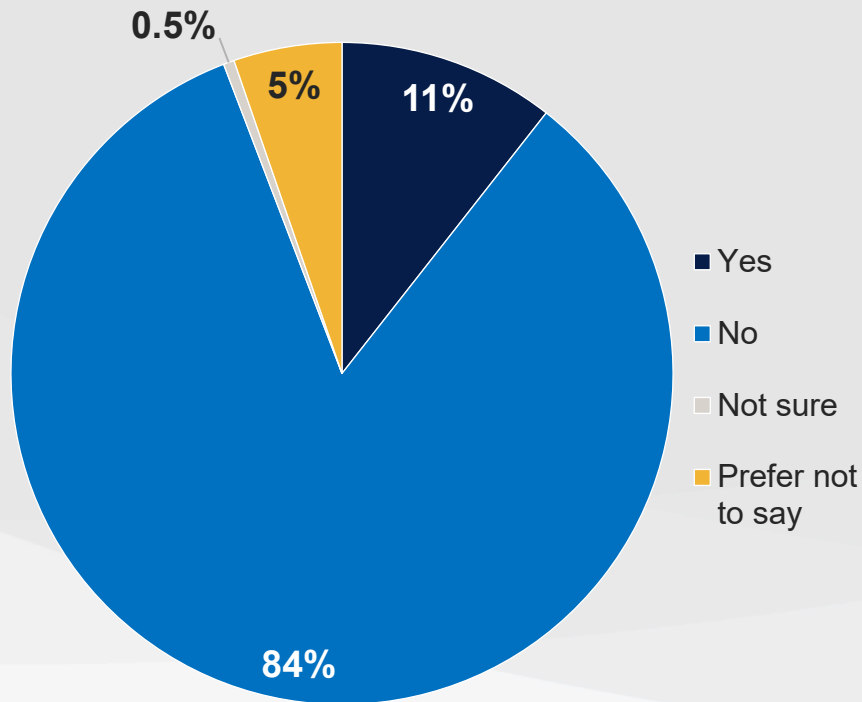


Do you consider yourself Hispanic or Latino/a/x?

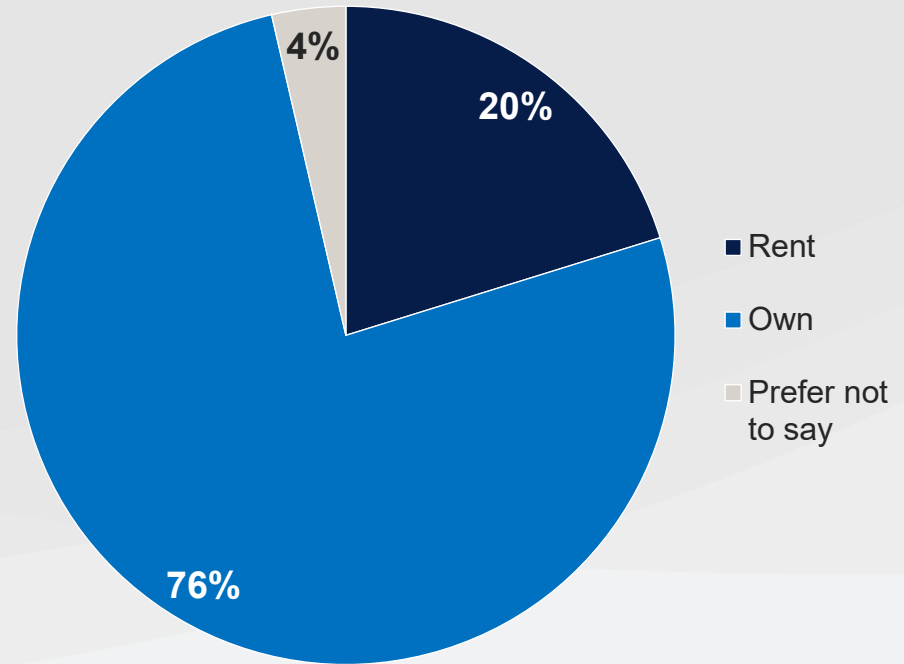
