

Ramsey County and the City of Saint Paul are working to improve transit service along West 7th Street between downtown Saint Paul, the Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport, and the Mall of America.






Survey Overview

The Riverview Corridor Station Area Planning Survey was made available to the public and focused on the neighborhoods surrounding three planned transit stations at St. Clair Avenue, Randolph Avenue, and Otto Avenue. Valuable input from the community will help inform and create plans to guide future growth and development at transit stops along West 7th. While open to the public, the survey collected a total of 341 responses with a 66% completion rate.









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


How important do you consider the following to the future of the St. Clair, Randolph, and Otto areas?









With which of the following races do you most closely identify?


