Ramsey County Sheriff's Office to Hold Explorers Information Night for Students and Parents

Students interested in law enforcement careers are encouraged to attend the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office Annual Law Enforcement Career Exploring Informational Meeting on Thursday, September 22, 2016 at 6:30 pm at the Sheriff's Water Patrol Office, 5 South Owasso Boulevard, Little Canada.

The Law Enforcement Career Exploring Program is open to youth (male and female) ages 14 through 20 years old with an interest in learning more about careers in public safety. In affiliation with the Boy Scouts of America Learning for Life, the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office sponsors Explorer Post #2 which provides youth with education, training, first-hand career experience, leadership opportunities and community service activities. The program goal is to encourage youth to become responsible citizens of the community and nation.

"Connecting with youth is a vital part of building relationships between law enforcement and the community," states Sheriff Matt Bostrom. "The Explorers Program is an excellent opportunity for our young citizens to have a great educational experience that lasts a lifetime." The Sheriff encourages both parents and youth to attend the First Nighter meeting.

RCSO Explorer Post #2 is a national Law Enforcement Exploring Post that competes annually at the Law Enforcement Exploring Competition. Explorers also help the Sheriff's Office with community events; assist with certain activities, such as alcohol and tobacco compliance checks; and partner with the Water Patrol using boats and ATVs. Fifteen students on average attend the RCSO Explorer Academy each year. Explorer Post #2 was established in 1957 and is the oldest post in Minnesota.
