

# **Notable Crimes Report**

The Notable Crimes Report is a weekly bulletin with some of the noteworthy crimes that occurred in Ramsey County for the given week. The purpose of this bulletin is to educate the community on crime trends and provide insight to the types of situations that law enforcement faces on a daily basis.

**Person Shot** 

Date and Time: February 13, 2021 at 1:45 pm

**Location:** 2200 block of Stewart Avenue, Saint Paul

Police responded to a 9-1-1 call for a male being shot in the stomach. Police located the victim inside an apartment complex. The victim stated he heard a dozen gunshots and fled into an apartment. The victim was transported to a local hospital. Several bullet casings were found at the crime scene.

Robberv

Date and Time: February 13, 2021 at 3:57 pm

**Location:** 1300 block of Arkwright Street, Saint Paul

The male victim was sitting in his parked vehicle in an apartment parking lot. A sedan pulled in next to him and parked. A male exited the sedan and entered the victim's vehicle via the front passenger door. A second male exited the sedan and opened the victim's car door. The male suspects demanded the victim's cellphone and wallet. The victim refused. The front passenger male suspect exited the victim's vehicle and came around to the driver side. The victim then shifted his car into drive and sped away from the scene. The suspects got back into their sedan and chased after the victim. During the chase the suspects fired a gunshot at the victim's vehicle. The suspects then stopped chasing the victim and drove away.

### **Attempted Motor Vehicle Theft**

Date and Time: February 13, 2021 at 6:26 pm

**Location:** 900 block of Dale Street North, Saint Paul

A 9-1-1 caller reported four males attempted to steal his vehicle. One suspect was able to get into the caller's car. The other three suspects were in a sedan. The caller had fled the scene already and did not wish to file a report.

#### **Motor Vehicle Theft**

Date and Time: February 16, 2021 at 10:15 pm

**Location:** 600 block of Central Avenue West, Saint Paul

A victim's running vehicle was stolen while her two toddlers were in the backseat. Approximately 15 minutes later, a 9-1-1 caller reported seeing two young children wandering in the area of Snelling Avenue North and Charles Avenue. Police were able to find the children. The stolen vehicle was soon located four blocks away from where the children were found. The suspect was not located.

#### Fight Over a Stolen Vehicle

Date and Time: February 17, 2021 at 12:19 pm

**Location:** 1000 block of Red Fox Road, Vadnais Heights

Deputies responded to a 9-1-1 call for a fight involving five males in the parking lot of a restaurant. One suspect was reported to have a crowbar. Deputies discovered one of the vehicles associated with the fight was stolen from Edina. The altercation arose out of a dispute over the stolen vehicle. No one was injured and the vehicle was returned to its owner.

**Carjacking at Gunpoint** 

Date and Time: February 17, 2021 at 5:00 pm

**Location:** 1500 block of Eustis Street, Saint Anthony

A victim was carjacked at gunpoint by a male suspect who displayed a handgun.

**Multiple Stolen Vehicles** 

Date and Time: February 17, 2021 at 5:54 pm

**Location:** Highway 280 & Larpenteur Avenue, Saint Paul

Police began following a vehicle that was stolen from Washington County. The suspect vehicle was traveling with another vehicle that was reported stolen at gunpoint by Saint Anthony Police Department. The first suspect crashed their stolen car at Aldine Street and then got into the other stolen car. The two suspects fled at a high rate of speed. Police were not able to pursue.

**Gunshots Fired Between Vehicles** 

**Date and Time:** February 17, 2021 at 10:52 pm 100 block of Case Avenue, Saint Paul

Multiple 9-1-1 callers reported hearing multiple gunshots in the area. Two cars were reportedly

chasing and shooting at each other. One of the vehicles crashed into a parked car.
