



# Notable Crimes Report

4/2/2021 – 4/9/2021

*The Notable Crimes Report is a weekly bulletin with some of the noteworthy crimes that occurred in Ramsey County for the given week. The purpose of this bulletin is to educate the community on crime trends and provide insight to the types of situations that law enforcement faces on a daily basis.*

## Stolen Vehicle

**Date and Time:** April 2, 2021 at 12:42 am

**Location:** 500 block of Thomas Avenue, Saint Paul

Officers were patrolling the area of Thomas Avenue when they encountered a vehicle that was stolen. The vehicle was wanted in multiple car jackings throughout Saint Paul. Four juvenile suspects in the vehicle fled as officers approached the vehicle. Officers pursued on foot but were not able to locate the suspects.

## Stolen Motorcycle & Accident with Injuries

**Date and Time:** April 2, 2021 at 8:49 pm

**Location:** 1400 block of Victoria Way, Saint Paul

Officers responded to 9-1-1 call for a report of a motorcycle accident with injuries. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect after they learned that a motorcycle was stolen, which was involved in the accident. The suspect was arrested and booked.

## Shots Fired

**Date and Time:** April 3, 2021 at 1:09 am

**Location:** Phalen Boulevard / Atlantic Street, Saint Paul

Deputies conducted a traffic stop on a car that was in the area of a shots fired call in Saint Paul. One adult and three juveniles were arrested after two handguns were found in the car. The investigation is ongoing.

## Catalytic Converter Theft

**Date and Time:** April 3, 2021 at 5:26 am

**Location:** 900 block of Tanglewood Drive, Shoreview

Deputies responded to a 9-1-1 call for an in-progress catalytic converter theft. When the deputies arrived on scene the suspect vehicle fled, which led to a pursuit. The suspect then fled on foot from the vehicle and officers set up a perimeter to locate the suspect. The suspect was located and was arrested. In the suspect's vehicle, there were multiple burglary tools and catalytic converters.

## Shooting

**Date and Time:** April 5, 2021 at 4:13 pm

**Location:** White Bear Avenue North & Euclid Street, Saint Paul

Officers responded to a 9-1-1 call on a report of a shooting involving vehicles. When officers arrived on scene, they discovered 11 shell casings near the shooting location. Officers learned that a child was grazed by a bullet during the shooting and had been taken to a local hospital prior to the officers arriving.

**Traffic Stop Leads to Arrest**

**Date and Time:** April 6, 2021 at 1:47 am

**Location:** County Road B East / Edgerton Street North, Maplewood

A deputy made a traffic stop for expired registration and moving violations. The deputy discovered that the driver was unlicensed to drive and had no insurance for the vehicle. A passenger in the vehicle had an Anoka County felony warrant. Deputies discovered stolen credit cards, drugs, and counterfeit currency inside the vehicle upon completing a search. Both the driver and the passenger were taken into custody.

**Vehicle Fire**

**Date and Time:** April 6, 2021 at 9:05 pm

**Location:** 200 block of Milford Street, Saint Paul

Officers responded to a 9-1-1 call on a report of a vehicle that blew up in flames. Firefighters arrived on scene to put out the fire. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.

**Shots Fired**

**Date and Time:** April 6, 2021 at 11:58 pm

**Location:** 400 block of Thomas Avenue, Saint Paul

Officers responded to multiple 9-1-1 calls on reports of multiple shots fired. A caller stated their son was shot. Officers arrived on scene and found a juvenile with a gunshot wound to the leg. The juvenile was transported to a local hospital. While on the scene, officers searched the area and found multiple shell casings.

**Vehicles on Fire**

**Date and Time:** April 6, 2021 at 12:41 am

**Location:** 100 block of Bates Avenue, Saint Paul

Officers responded to the 100 block of Bates Avenue on a report of two vehicles on fire in an alley. There was no suspect information provided. An investigation is being conducted by arson investigators.
