



Notable Crimes Report

4/30/2021 – 5/7/2021

The Notable Crimes Report is a weekly bulletin with some of the noteworthy crimes that occurred in Ramsey County for the given week. The purpose of this bulletin is to educate the community on crime trends and provide insight to the types of situations that law enforcement faces on a daily basis.

Shots Fired	
Date and Time:	May 1, 2021 at 5:08 pm
Location:	700 block of Magnolia Avenue, Saint Paul
Two male suspects with handguns fired one shot each into a victim's vehicle. The vehicle fled towards the north. Multiple shell casings were recovered at the scene.	

Shots Fired	
Date and Time:	May 1, 2021 at 11:30 pm
Location:	544 Central Avenue, Saint Paul
Multiple 9-1-1 callers reported over 30 shots fired in the area. Broken glass was found at a school as well as multiple vehicles with bullet holes. A pistol magazine was also located in the roadway. Over 40 shell casings were recovered at the scene. Two individuals were interviewed and said three male suspects had shot at them.	

Shots Fired	
Date and Time:	May 2, 2021 at 1:30 am
Location:	600 block of Rice Street, Saint Paul
There was an incident at a gas station involving a fight and an attempt to hit a pedestrian with a vehicle. Shots were fired and 24 shell casings were recovered at the scene.	

Shots Fired	
Date and Time:	May 2, 2021 at 2:00 am
Location:	800 block of Selby Avenue, Saint Paul
At a known problem property on Selby Avenue, gunfire broke out at a house party attended by upwards of 100 people. Over 100 shell casings were recovered at the scene and at least five people were injured.	

Shots Fired	
Date and Time:	May 2, 2021 at 1:20 pm
Location:	1000 block of Edgerton Street, Saint Paul
A 9-1-1 caller reported shots fired and two male suspects running from a vehicle. Officers located the unoccupied vehicle and found a handgun with an extended magazine containing live ammunition inside. No casings were recovered but one nearby vehicle was found to have been struck by bullets.	

Shots Fired/Accident rollover	
Date and Time:	May 3, 2021 at 12:59 am
Location:	Maryland Avenue & Johnson Parkway, Saint Paul
Officers responded to reports of a rollover crash and shots fired in the area. A male victim was found in the road and was pronounced dead at the scene. Witnesses reported seeing two vehicles speeding down Maryland Avenue, hearing a series of gunshots, a crash, then more gunfire. A handgun was recovered at the scene.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: May 3, 2021 at 9:38 pm

Location: 1300 block of Edgerton Street, Saint Paul

Officers responded to a 9-1-1 call for multiple shots fired in the area. The block was lined with vehicles and a memorial event was being held for a young man killed in a vehicle accident the previous night. The homeowner did not know who fired a weapon. The attendees dispersed and four shell casings were found in the yard at the scene.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: May 4, 2021 at 4:30 pm

Location: Maryland Avenue & Arundel Street, Saint Paul

There was a report of shots fired at Arundel and Maryland. A short time later a vehicle crashed at the intersection of Rice and Cook. The driver of the crashed vehicle had a gunshot wound sustained at the shots fired scene at Arundel and Maryland. Four shell casings were located at the scene

Shots Fired

Date and Time: May 4, 2021 at 11:50 pm

Location: 100 block of Arlington Avenue East, Saint Paul

Multiple 9-1-1 callers reported hearing upwards of eight shots fired in the area. A witness reported seeing three vehicles speeding through a gas station lot and firing from the moving vehicles. Shell casings were recovered from the scene.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: May 5, 2021 at 1:25 am

Location: 1100 block of Marion Street, Saint Paul

Multiple 9-1-1 callers reported hearing around 20 shots fired in the area. A witness reported seeing a male suspect running while firing shots. Multiple shell casings were recovered on the 200 block of Geranium Avenue.
