



Notable Crimes Report

The Notable Crimes Report is a weekly bulletin with some of the noteworthy crimes that occurred in Ramsey County for the given week. The purpose of this bulletin is to educate the community on crime trends and provide insight to the types of situations that law enforcement faces on a daily basis.

Robbery

Date and Time: May 22, 2021 at 9:22 pm
Location: 5900 block of Hodgson Road, Shoreview

At a local gas station, a male approached the clerk. The male had a gun and told the clerk to put money in a bag. The male suspect then told the clerk to get on the ground. The suspect then fled from the store.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: May 22, 2021 at 10:08 pm
Location: 800 block of Sherburne Avenue, Saint Paul

Officers were dispatched to a report of 8-10 gunshots in the area. Several spent casings were located in the street, no suspect was found.

Carjacking

Date and Time: May 23, 2021 at 3:58 pm
Location: Maryland Avenue East and Clarence Street, Saint Paul

A man was walking away from his parked car when two teenage females took his car keys from him. A brief scuffle occurred. However, the teenage were able to get away with both the victim's car keys and his car.

Robbery

Date and Time: May 23, 2021 at 6:22 pm
Location: 1900 block of Beechwood Avenue, Saint Paul

A male, armed with a gun, jumped out of an older SUV and forcibly took a purse from a woman. The male ran back into the SUV and fled the scene.

Traffic

Date and Time: May 24, 2021 at 12:31 am
Location: Magnolia Avenue East and Johnson Parkway, Saint Paul

While on patrol, officers located an older SUV that matched the robbery suspect from 19xx Beechwood. A traffic stop was attempted, but the SUV fled from squads. A brief pursuit was initiated and quickly cancelled. Shortly afterwards, squads found the SUV involved in a two-vehicle accident at Cottage Avenue East and White Bear Avenue. A juvenile suspect was transported to the hospital.

Robbery, Assault, and Warrant Suspect

Date and Time: May 24, 2021 at 8:36 pm
Location: Lowertown and East Side of Saint Paul

Starting at 8:36 pm, a Lowertown liquor store employee stated he was held at gunpoint and a bottle of vodka was taken. The suspect was a 20-30 year old male. At 9:55 pm, an East side tobacco store stated a male held an employee at gun point and stole some cigars. An East Side group home reported at 11:29 pm that a male entered the home with a gun and asked for a lighter. Around 11:55 pm, a 9-1-1 caller reported that a male was over and stated that he robbed a liquor store. The male then left the caller's home. Suspect is known and wanted.

Vehicle Pursuit

Date and Time: May 24, 2021 at 3:20 am

Location: Interstate 35E and Highway 96, White Bear Lake

Deputy observed a vehicle driving over 100 mph in a 70 mph zone. Deputy initiated a traffic stop and the vehicle sped away leading to a vehicle pursuit for two miles. Vehicle stopped as the suspect was low on gas. Suspect was taken into custody and booked for fleeing peace officer in a motor vehicle.

Assault - Stabbing

Date and Time: May 24, 2021 at 4:14 pm

Location: Maryland Avenue and Jessie Street, Saint Paul

Officers were dispatched to multiple reports of stabbing in the area. A male suspect stabbed another male. Officers arrived on scene and found a victim with stab wound to the right forearm. Suspect was taken into custody. Victim was transported to the hospital.

Assault

Date and Time: May 24, 2021 at 5:08 pm

Location: 1000 block of Payne Avenue East, Saint Paul

Officers responded to multiple 9-1-1 calls for a report of 6 gunshots and someone has been shot in the area. Multiple spent casings were found in the area. The victim had left the area in a vehicle and suspect ran down the street.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: May 24, 2021 at 1:00 am

Location: 100 block of Winnipeg Avenue, Saint Paul

Officers heard 15-20 gunshots in the area and multiple callers reported the same. A caller stated that two male suspects were running down the street and shooting. Officers found a bullet hole in 800 block of Rice Street and located several casings in 800 block of Albemarle Street. Officers also located additional casings at Milford Street and Simcoe Street.
