

Notable Crimes Report

The Notable Crimes Report is a weekly bulletin with some of the noteworthy crimes that occurred in Ramsey County for the given week. The purpose of this bulletin is to educate the community on crime trends and provide insight to the types of situations that law enforcement faces on a daily basis.

Stolen Vehicle

Date and Time: July 2, 2021 at 5:42 pm

Location: Brady St and Magnolia Ave E, Saint Paul

Officers stopped a vehicle that had no license plate. The driver exited the vehicle and began to walk away. There were three passengers left in the vehicle. One had a warrant and was arrested for the warrant. Officers ran the vehicle identification number on the car and it was reported as a stolen vehicle out of Crystal. Responding Officers were able to locate the driver. The driver was arrested for Receiving Stolen Property.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: July 3, 2021 at 12:40 am

Location: 800 block of Rice St, Saint Paul

Multiple shots were fired in the area. Casings were located at Rice and Milford and at Rice and

Winnipeg. Several parked vehicles were struck. No gunshot injuries were reported.

Shooting of Bystander

Date and Time: July 3, 2021 at 10:56pm

Location: 100 block of Biglow Ln, Saint Paul

A male and a female were driving on Biglow Ln when they heard a gunshot. The female front passenger then reported feeling a burning sensation in her back. Officers arrived on scene and recovered a protruding bullet fragment in the front passenger seat. The bullet had gone through the trunk, rear seat, and the front seat before striking the victim.

Robbery

Date and Time: July 4, 2021 at 3:55pm

Location: 50 block of Avon St S, Saint Paul

Three people were walking along Grand Avenue and attempting to cross Avon Street South. A vehicle travelling northbound on Avon St S stopped at Grand Ave to allow them to cross Avon. The vehicle then turned onto Grand Ave and circled back towards the three people. The driver exited the car and approached the three. The driver had a handgun and demanded for the victims' purses and wallets. One victim was struck with a handgun.

Shots Fired

Date and Time: July 4, 2021 at 9:29pm

Location: Margaret St and Cypress St, Saint Paul

Officers responded to a call of 12-13 shots being fired. Witnesses reported seeing a male firing a handgun into the air before shooting at a black Chevrolet Tahoe. Witnesses also observed six to seven males picking up casings from the ground. No gunshot victims were reported.

Assault

Date and Time: July 7, 2021 at 6:51 pm

Location: Maryland Ave & Westminster, Saint Paul

Victim was walking on Maryland towards Westminster when a sedan pulled up next to victim to give him a ride. Suspect drove to the area of 1300 block of Westminster and stopped, where the suspect demanded the victim's backpack and wallet, and punched the victim in the face. Suspect then pulled out a black handgun and again told the victim to give him money or he would kill him. Suspect took the victim's black backpack containing \$500 in cash, and his wallet.

Pursuit

Date and Time: July 8, 2021 at 3:21 am

Location: East metro area

Deputies assisted the Minnesota State Patrol who were in pursuit of a fleeing vehicle. The State Patrol Helicopter called out the pursuit and Maplewood Police successfully deployed stop sticks. The vehicle continued and the helicopter gave updates. The suspect vehicle stopped and the four occupants fled. A Deputy arrested one of the passengers as the other three occupants fled from the vehicle. North Saint Paul Police arrested another suspect. As squads broke down the perimeter, Deputies located the remaining two suspects hiding under a pine tree. All four occupants were 14 years old and lived in the cities of Maplewood, White Bear Lake, and Saint Paul. Two suspects were booked for fleeing police in a motor vehicle. The other two were brought to their homes.

Date and Time: July 8, 2021 at 10:55 pm

Location: Robert Frontage Road & Stevens, Saint Paul

An Officer in the area heard 6-7 shots. 10 casings were recovered of at least two different calibers at

Robert Frontage Rd & Stevens.
