



This summary includes public information related to the charging, bail conditions, prosecution, sentencing, and probation of serious and career offenders to ensure accountability and transparency of the justice system in keeping the community safe.

**Christopher Allen Stengle
Age 52 • Saint Paul**

Christopher Allen Stengle, age 52 of Saint Paul, is a serious offender; he has had multiple recent police contacts throughout Ramsey County.

On July 21, 2021, Stengle was booked into the Ramsey County Jail after being picked up in Chisago County on a Ramsey County warrant for not complying with the requirements of his conditional release.

Stengle was booked on a Felony Assault, 5th degree with 2 or more previous convictions in 3 years. Stengle appeared in court on Thursday, September 23rd in front of Judge Olmstead; she accepted his plea of guilty and sentenced him to 50 days – with credit for the 50 days he has been in custody. Stengle remains in custody; he will be transported to Washington county where he will have to answer to a Felony drug possession case.
