New MFIP changes create more opportunities for MFIP families to continue their education, improve skills and Earn and Learn while in school.

Effective immediately:

- More time for all education and training activities.
- Enrollment in Adult Basic Education or GED preparation classes.
- Enrollment in English as a Second Language or Functional Work Literacy classes.
- Four year college programs instead of 24 months only.
- No time limits for English as Second Language, Functional Work Literacy, and Adult Basic Education and GED coursework.
