- Improve your basic skills by attending Adult Basic Education Classes
- Improve your English, attend English as a Second Language or Functional Work Literacy Classes for as long as you need to while you are on MFIP
- Earn your GED and get close to the job that supports your family
- Get a degree! Attend an accredited 4 year college/university for 48 months instead 24 months
