SUBJECT: Work Benefit Policy Termination

Effective December 1, 2014 the Work Benefit program has been “suspended” by the State of Minnesota. What this means is that all clients who currently receive benefits for WB will no longer receive them and any future potential eligibility for the program has been eliminated.

Notices have been sent out to all clients who were receiving WB on November 1st by the State. Any clients that might have been potentially eligible for benefits beginning December first will be also be notified this month as financial workers process those cases.

Here’s the body of the notice that was mailed out on November 1, 2014 to current WB recipients.

THE LAW HAS CHANGED FOR THE WORK BENEFIT (WB) PROGRAM:
