Driver's License Discussion

Snyder, Director of the Opportunity Youth Network at Youthprise, shared on their Opportunity Youth Recovery Plan. One aspect is to publicly fund youth to obtain their driver's licenses (training, behind the wheel, and an option to have teachers sign off on the license, affordable insurance pool), a critical employment credential in the new workforce. There are a lot of barriers that keep young people from getting their driver's license, e.g., blocks employment, limits housing. She also shared some possible solutions and recommendations. Becker mentioned the partnership with Ramsey County and the City of St. Paul in establishing a Drivers Academy Pilot.

Xcel/CEE Construction Workforce Training Program

Duffrin shared details about Xcel Energy's five-week home energy career training pilot program. This program will improve workforce diversity in the Minnesota energy sector's construction efforts which

gained approval last week from the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission. The first cohort will be launched in March.

Stark stated that Xcel has another \$4 million workforce development program in the solar area.
